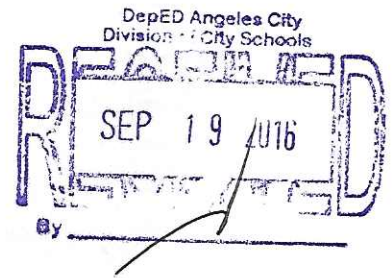
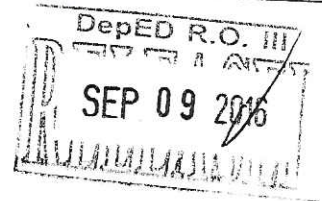

This is to inform all concerned that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines Central Luzon Region will be holding World Scout Environment Education Course to be held at SPED-G, East Kalayaan, Subic Freeport Zone, Olongapo City on October 27-30, 2016.

Participants to the course should be currently registered adult leader and at least Wood Badge Holder. The course is open to council commissioners for KAB Scouting, Boy Scouting, and Senior Scouting as well as Unit Leaders handling scout units.

Each local council shall send at least two trained leaders for 2 KAB Scouting, Boy Scouting, and Senior Scouting. The Registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00) shall be charged each participant to defray the cost for meals (dinner of October 27 until lunch of October 30), course materials (ID, notebook, ballpen, manila paper, other supplies) and other administrative costs.
