We hope that this humble request merits your positive response.



GENERAL MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES OF THE INTER-SCHOOL ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

- 1. The essay writing contest is open to Grades 7-10 students of public and private secondary schools in Pampanga.
- 2. All participants must attend the opening of the Angeles City Book Fair at the G/F Newpoint Mall, Angeles City on 16 November 2016, Wednesday, at 1:00 p.m.
- 3. The theme of the essay will be the official theme of the 82nd National Book Week, "Today's Readers: Inclusivity in Diversity".
- 4. The essay should be written in English, not be more than 300 words, handwritten.
- 5. The contestant's name and school must be written on a separate sheet of paper and stapled or attached at the back of the entry.
- 6. All entries will become the property of Angeles City Library and Information Center.
- 7. The criteria for judging will be as follows:

Organization - 35%
Relevance to the Theme - 35%
Mechanics - 30%
TOTAL 100%

8. The winners will receive the following prizes:

1st Prize – P2,000.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school 2nd Prize – P1,500.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school 3rd Prize – P1,000.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school

9. Deadline for submission of entries is on 17 November 2016, Thursday, 1:00 PM at Adarna Publishing House booth, Newpoint Mall, Angeles City.
