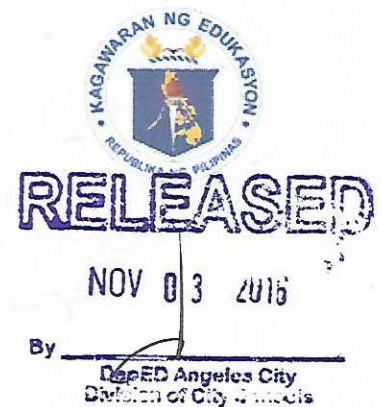

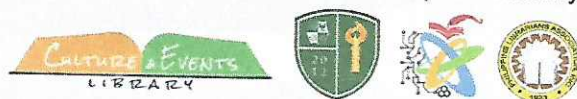

### GENERAL MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES OF THE INTER-SCHOOL ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

1. The essay writing contest is open to Grades 7-10 students of public and private secondary schools in Pampanga.
2. All participants must attend the opening of the Angeles City Book Fair at the G/F Newpoint Mall, Angeles City on 16 November 2016, Wednesday, at 1:00 p.m.
3. The theme of the essay will be the official theme of the 82<sup>nd</sup> National Book Week, *"Today's Readers: Inclusivity in Diversity"*.
4. The essay should be written in English, not be more than 300 words, handwritten.
5. The contestant's name and school must be written on a separate sheet of paper and stapled or attached at the back of the entry.
6. All entries will become the property of Angeles City Library and Information Center.
7. The criteria for judging will be as follows:
 

Organization	-	35%
Relevance to the Theme	-	35%
Mechanics	-	<u>30%</u>
<b>TOTAL</b>		<b>100%</b>
8. The winners will receive the following prizes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Prize – P2,000.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize – P1,500.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize – P1,000.00 and a Certificate of Recognition for the school
9. Deadline for submission of entries is on 17 November 2016, Thursday, 1:00 PM at Adarna Publishing House booth, Newpoint Mall, Angeles City.
