**RESOLUTION NO. 7739, S-2017
(PR-350-06-17)**

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DEP-ED) ORDER NO. 13 ISSUED LAST MARCH 14, BANNING THE MARKETING OF SOFTDRINKS AND JUNK FOODS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS ALL OVER THE COUNTRY IN A BID TO PROMOTE HEALTHY EATING AMONG STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.

WHEREAS, DepEd Secretary Leonor Briones has issued a Department Order providing policies and guidelines on healthy food and beverage choices in schools and all Education Department Offices;

WHEREAS, DepEd classified that only food under "green" category such as unsweetened milk, unsweetened buco juice, water, rice, chicken, lean meat, fish and fresh fruits should always be available in school canteens;

WHEREAS, foods that are classified under "yellow" category such as fruit juices, fried rice, bread using refined flour, biscuits, pancakes, sandwiches, processed food, and stir-fried vegetables should be served carefully;

WHEREAS, softdrinks, sports water, products containing caffeine, ice cream, cakes, donuts, French fries, instant noodles, chicken skin, bacon, junk food and canned fruits in heavy syrup should be totally prohibited in school canteens;

WHEREAS, the DepEd Order No. 13 is necessary to promote healthier lifestyle among Filipinos, especially the youth.


Now therefore, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Angeles City in session assembled that a resolution expressing support to the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 13 issued last March 14, banning the marketing of softdrinks and junk foods in public schools all over the country in a bid to promote healthy eating among students and teachers be, as it is hereby, approved.


