**2017 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S SCIENCE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP OF THE PHILIPPINE
SOCIETY OF YOUTH SCIENCE CLUBS INC.**

The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC) Inc. will conduct the 2017 National Children's Science Interactive Workshop (NCSIW) with the theme Chemical X: Decrypting the Secret Formula from December 18 to 21, 2017 in Mainland Luzon.

The NCSIW aims to promote current trends and breakthroughs in ST&E with their different impacts, issues, and relevance to our society and to elementary science club members and their advisers. Specifically, it aims to:

1. provide the participants with a thorough understanding of the concepts and impact of Chemistry and its multi-disciplinary fields through interaction with experts in the field;
2. provide a venue for the exchange of ideas and promote camaraderie among them; and
3. encourage them to join science clubs and to be involved with their teachers in the science clubbing movement.

The target participants are elementary science club members (Grades 4-6) and their advisers from both public and private schools nationwide.

The deadline for submission of registration forms is on or before November 24, 2017, Friday, together with the complete list of participants per school or science club. Beyond this date, participants who are not on the list will not be covered by insurance.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
