2014 WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

- 1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 224, s. 1998 declaring the first week of March each year as Women's Week and Women's Right and International Peace Day, Proclamation No. 227, s. 1988 providing for the observance of the Month of March as Women's Role in History Month and Republic Act 6949, s. 1990 declaring March 8 of every year as National Women's Day, this Division will conduct various school-based activities to celebrate the diverse and historic accomplishments of women.
