#### MUSLIM LEARNERS' DATA INVENTORY

To: Public School District Supervisors
Elementary/Secondary School Principals
Head Teachers/Officers-In-Charge
All concerned

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2011 "Amendment to DepEd Order No. 1, s. 2004 (Standard Curriculum for Elementary Public Schools and Private Madaris)" that all elementary public schools with at least fifteen (15) Muslim pupils and recipient private Madaris are enjoined to implement the Refined Elementary Madrasah Curriculum (REMC) contained in the enclosure.
- 2. The REMC aims to:
  - a. Establish a smooth transfer of Muslim pupils from recipient private Madrasah to public schools with ALIVE Program or vice versa;
  - b. Unify the long history of dichotomy of education among Muslims; and
  - c. Promote the Filipino national identity at the same time preserve the Filipino Muslim's cultural heritage.
- 3. In line with this, seven schools with current ALIVE Program are required to hold a school based meeting with asatidz and parents of the ALIVE learners on or before June 26, 2015.
- 4. Herewith are the enclosures to DepEd Order No. 40. s. 2011, Muslim learners data inventory, teacher's load, ALIVE learners' master list and parents' meeting schedule. To be submitted on June 26, 2015.
- 5. Secondary schools should only submit the Muslim Learners' Data Inventory.
