**Orientation on National School Deworming Day (NSDD)**

1. Due to the high prevalence of children affected by intestinal parasitic infections which may lead to cognitive impairment and malnutrition, among other complications, the **Department of Health** in coordination with the **Department of Education**, will conduct a simultaneous deworming of approximately 16 million school-aged children (Kindergarten to Grade VI) enrolled in public elementary schools on July 29, 2015 through the National School Deworming Day (NSDD) initiative.
2. In consideration of the immense coverage of the said activity, all Heads of public elementary schools in this Division are requested to assign the school Clinic Teacher to act as a **Mass Drug Administration Provider (MDAP)** and will administer the deworming drugs assisted by a Barangay Health worker/Community Health Team or PTA representative.
3. In this regard, an orientation on the NSDD Guidelines shall be conducted on July 22, 2015, Wednesday from 8:30am to 11:00 am at the Gabaldon Bldg., Jesus St., Pulunbulu, Angeles City to facilitate and ensure the proper implementation of the Mass Drug Administration during the National School Deworming Day.  
Participants to the said activity are as follows:
  - a. Heads of all Public Elementary Schools Angeles City
  - b. One (1) School Clinic Teacher from Public Elementary Schools Angeles City
  - c. Two (2) School PTA Officers from Public Elementary Schools Angeles City
