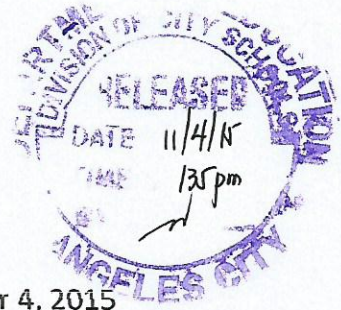

3. The screening of documents will be on **November 19-20 and 23-24, 2015, 2:00 – 5:00 PM** at the Division Office, Angeles City.
4. The function of the DSAC are the following:
  - a. The DSAC shall take charge of the examination of documents and accreditation of athletes, coaches and chaperons. Completion of all documents shall be done using the Rules and Guidelines for the Screening and Accreditation of Athletes, Coaches and Chaperons.
  - b. Supervise the fielding of teams before the games are played to prevent impersonation. They shall countercheck the participating athletes with the records submitted to ensure that only accredited athletes are allowed to play.
  - c. The DSAC shall take custody of all records of athletes. All matter relative to athletes' eligibility shall be referred to the DSAC.
