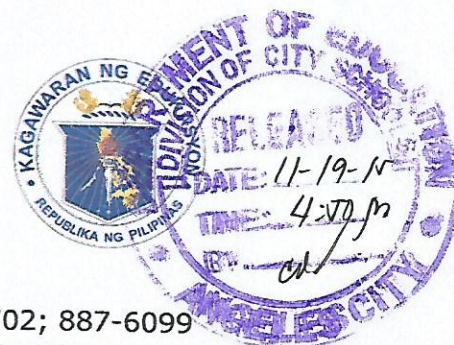

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 2399 dated February 25, 1985 designating the second week of December of every year as Education Week, the DepEd-Angeles City will celebrate the 2015 Division Education Week from December 1 to 7, 2015.

2. Education Week is an opportunity to promote and showcase the immense role of education has in producing engaged, successful students and educators. One of the main events to be held throughout the week, is to put a spotlight on the diversity and depth of talents of the students in the public elementary and secondary schools to recognize their many skills and accomplishments which will surely offer a festive social event.

December 1, 2015 – School-Based Education Week Celebration (8:00am to 5:00pm)


December 2, 2015 - Systems Plus College Foundation, Secondary
