- 2. In this regard, each District in the Division of Angeles City from both Public and Private elementary and secondary schools are requested to send representatives/contestants for **the 2 separate events**.
- 3. All participants/contestants are required to wear their respective <u>school uniform</u> for both events and are discouraged from wearing any costume as this will have no bearing on the score or on the criteria for judging.

MECHNICS OF THE CONTEST

- The poster must depict the theme of this year's Nutrition Month Celebration, "FIRST 1000 DAYS NI BABY PAHALAGAHAN PARA SA MALUSOG NA KINABUKASAN".
- 2. Participants to this activity are the following:
 - 1.1. Elementary Level
 - Public Elementary Schools Two (2) per District
 - 2. Private Elementary Schools One (1) per School
 - 2.2. Secondary Level
 - Public Secondary Schools One (1) per School
 - Private Secondary Schools One (1) per School
- 3. All participants must be officially enrolled during the current year in the school that he/she represents as certified by the School Principal.
- 4. Materials to be used:
 - a. Illustration Board 18"x24", to be provided and prepared by the contestant before the contest proper.
 - b. Medium shall be any or combination of crayons pastel, charcoal, water color, oil paint and poster paint, all of which are to be provided by the contestant.
- 5. Preferably no text/caption but instead the picture on the poster should depict the theme in focus.
- 6. Criteria for Judging

VENUE

Creativity - 20%
Relevance - 20%
Neatness - 20%
Originality - 20%
Overall Impact - 20
Total - 100%

- 7. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and non-appealable.
- 8. Winning Entries shall become the properties of the City Nutrition Council (CNC) for its future Undertakings.
 - 9. Certificates and cash prizes will be awarded to the Winners.

MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST:

- 1. The Nutri Jingle piece must be focused on this year's theme, "FIRST 1000 DAYS NI BABY PAHALAGAHAN PARA SA MALUSOG NA KINABUKASAN".
- 2. Participants to this activity are the following:

2.1 Elementary Level

- 3. Public Elementary Schools Two (2) per District
- Private Elementary Schools One (1) per School

2.2. Secondary Level

- 3. Public Secondary Schools One (1) per School
- 4. Private Secondary School One (1) per School
- 3. Participating group must be composed of 10 members who are officially enrolled during the current year in the school that they represent as certified by the School Principal.
- 4. Members of participating groups are advised to be in their respective school uniform and are discouraged from wearing costumes of any kind as this would not have any effect on the scoring system.
- 5. Participating groups will be given a minimum of three minutes (3) and maximum of five(5) minutes to perform.
- 6. Four (4) copies of the jingle piece and typewritten list of the names of the contestants in double space on a long sized bond paper together with the name of the School at the back of each copy and duly signed by the coach and principal shall be submitted upon registration
- 7. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING ARE AS FOLLOWS:

ORIGINALITY 30% RELEVANCE 35% VOICE QUALITY 20% CHOREOGRAPHY 15%

- 8. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and non-appealable.
- 9. Certificates and cash prizes will be awarded to the winning groups
