**DIVISION MEMORANDUM**

**DIVISION PRE-REGIONAL MEET TRAINING ON STRATEGIC PLAYING,  
COACHING AND OFFICIATING FOR ACCREDITATION**

To: Public and Private Elementary, Secondary and Senior High Schools

1. Sport development is the promotion of sports activities which in turn, provide a forum to learn skills such as: self-restraint, confidence, leadership; convey core principles that are important in a democracy, such as: tolerance, cooperation and admiration; teach the fundamental value in managing essential steps in life; and internalize sports virtues and values such as: work ethics, teamwork, respect, discipline, camaraderie and overcoming adversity.
2. In this light, a Division Pre-Regional Meet Training on Strategic Playing, Coaching and Officiating for Accreditation will be conducted on November 25, 27, 28, 29, December 1, 2, 9, 16, 23, 2017, January 6, 13, 20, 27, 2018 to February 1, 2, 3, and 5, 2018, at 8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M., Gabaldon Building, Angeles City.
3. The objectives of the training are:
  - To develop an understanding of the importance of sport in the pursuit of a healthy and active lifestyle at the school and beyond;
  - To develop among the athletes the value of self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry,
  - To develop an appreciation of the concepts of rigid training, officiating and coaching;
  - To develop the capacity to maintain the interest of athletes, coaches and technical officials in a sport or sports and to persevere in order to achieve success;
  - To develop self-esteem and self-confidence through positive rigid training, coaching and officiating experiences; and
  - To ensure that athletes, coaches and technical officials can maximize their playing, coaching and officiating potential and find a sport that they can enjoy and participate in with some success.
4. Participants to this training are the 2017 ACAA winning athletes, coaches, Technical Officials and Tournament Managers.
