IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE TEACH ON: KEEPING THE PASSION ALIVE

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), is implementing **TEACH ON: Keeping the Passion Alive**, a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) for teachers.
- 2. This MOOC aims to inspire, rekindle and sustain teachers' passion for teaching, and improve their core competencies as DepEd teachers. It particularly targets Domain 7 of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST).
- 3. The program is open to qualified teachers who are digitally literate, can navigate and have access to the internet using a computer or smartphone, and are committed to complete the course.
- 4. The MOOC is equivalent to 40 training hours and is self-paced. Teachers have access to the course for two full months at any time of the day and at any location with internet connectivity. The first run of the course has been set to accommodate 5,000 DepEd teachers.

- 5. Successful course completers of TEACH ON will receive an international certificate of participation from SEAMEO INNOTECH. They will also be awarded 15 continuing professional development (CPD) units as approved by the Professional Regulation Commission.
- 6. Each region must send the editable Excel sheet file of its list of nominees—indicating the name, school, and schools division to scholarships@deped.gov.ph on or before December 3, 2019.
- 7. All identified participants are instructed to register at bit.ly/teachondeped1 and create an account at keep.edu.hk before enrolling in the course. Enclosed is the step-by-step guide on how to enroll and the answers to frequently asked questions (FAQs) which can be disseminated to the potential learners. Enrollment is now open. The detailed guide on how to enroll and the FAQs can be accessed through bit.ly/teachonenrolldeped and bit.ly/teachonfaqdeped.

The course, Teach On: Keeping the Passion Alive can be accessed through the KEEP (Knowledge and Education Exchange) Platform.

To enroll in the course you need to create an account in the KEEP platform (assuming you do not have an account yet) and then enroll in the course. Here's a step by step guide. If you already have a KEEP account, you can go straight to Step No. 5.




Verify Your KEEP Account


In order to activate your KEEP account, we need to verify your email address. Check your email joselitojr delacruz101@gmail.com for a verification email and follow the link to finish creating your KEEP account.

If your institution is linked with KEEP, take a minute to verify your account with your institution after activating your account.

 Go to your email and check the email from KEEP. Click on the activation link provided within that email. If you did not receive an activation link, please email support@keep.edu.hk.



After clicking on the activation link, you will be led to this log in page. Log in using your
email and the password you provided for KEEP. This means that you already have access
to the KEEP platform.



You will then be asked to fill in details for your account. Fill out the form.

Now that you have access to the KEEP platform, you can find the course, TEACH ON. To
enroll in the course. Go to the COURSE LINK:
https://course.keep.edu.hk/course/237975. The Course will run from November 25,
2019 to February 14, 2020.

It is important that you get the link correctly. Notice that each course run has a different course link.

5. Click the "Enroll" button



6. Log in using your keep account details.



You will only have access to the course contents when THE COURSE BEGINS.

Since you are already enrolled, the next time you log in, simply go back to the course link assigned to your course and log in. You will see a "View Course" button once the course opens.

The course is self-paced. This means that you can go through the course contents at your own pace and time as soon as the course begins. You can access the course any time of the day or night. This way you can manage your time in going through the course activities. It's up to you.
