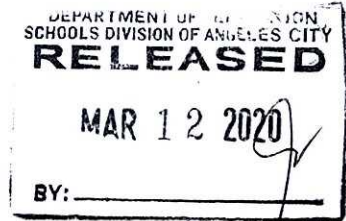

**SCHEDULE OF FOURTH QUARTER EXAMINATION AND
END-OF-SCHOOL-YEAR RITES**

To : All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads

1. Secretary Leonor M. Briones of the Department of Education (DepEd) issued an official statement last March 10, 2020 regarding the adoption of DepEd of social distancing measures for the remainder of School Year 2019-2020.

2. In relation to this and amidst the suspension of classes as declared by our City Mayor from March 10-13, this Office is issuing the following information for the guidance of all school heads, teachers, and learners.

2.1. Schedule of Fourth Quarter Examinations

2.1.1. Regular classes will be held in all public schools on March 16, 2020 in order to give time for teachers to meet their learners and inform them on the schedule of the final examinations and other academic-related tasks/activities.

2.1.2. Grade 6, Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners will be taking their final examinations on March 17-18, 2020. The rest of the grade levels (except for Grade 4 Learners who will be taking the ELLNA) will not be going to school on the given dates, but they will be accomplishing home-related tasks/assignments and will be reviewing their lessons.

2.1.2.1 Grade 4 learners of **Angeles Elementary School, Gov. Rafael L. Lazatin Integrated School, Pulung Cacutud Elementary School, Salapungan Elementary School, Sitio Pader Elementary School, Sta. Maria Elementary School, Alberto G. Pabalan Elementary School, Pampang Elementary School and San Ignacio Elementary School** are required to go to their respective schools for the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (ELLNA) on March 17, 2020, Tuesday.

2.1.3. Kinder to Grade 5 learners, as well as Grade 7 to Grade 9 learners and Grade 11 learners (except for those schools with learners who will take the National Achievement

Test) will have their final examinations on March 19-20, 2020. Therefore, Grade 6, Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners will not be going to school on the said dates in order to accomplish any further school requirements at the confines of their homes.

2.1.3.1. Grade 7 learners of **Angeles City National Trade School, Bonifacio V. Romero High School, Northville 15 Integrated School, Rafael L. Lazatin Memorial High School and Sto. Domingo Integrated School** will take the National Achievement Test (NAT) on March 19, 2020. As such, the aforementioned schools will have their final examinations for their Grade 7 to Grade 9 learners and Grade 11 learners on March 20 and 23, 2020. This will allow the said schools to utilize all their classrooms for the NAT and to give their Grade 7 learners a conducive and quiet environment during the test.

2.1.4. Grade 12 learners of **Angeles City National Trade School, Angeles City National High School, Rafael L. Lazatin Memorial High School, Sapangbato National High School and Sto. Domingo Integrated School** are required to go to their respective schools on March 25-26, 2020 for the Basic Education Exit Assessment (BEEA).


2.2. Moving up and Graduation Rites

2.2.1. The holding of moving up and graduation rites will be within the week of April 13-17, 2020 taking into consideration the applicable guidelines by the Department of Health (DOH). Should the public health situation prevent the holding of the graduation and moving up rites within the said week, the schools, in consultation with the PTA leadership, may choose to reschedule or forego the holding of graduation and moving up rites.

2.2.1.1. Anent to this, a revised schedule on the checking of forms will be issued in a separate memorandum.

3. It is reiterated by this Office that our students will be advised to make handwashing a habit and to avoid going to crowded places like malls, movie houses and public markets.

4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
