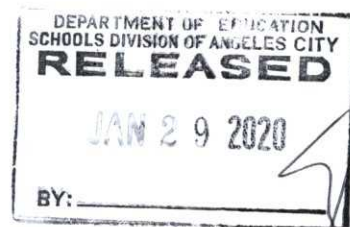

BSP ANGELES CITY COUNCIL 16TH CITY WIDE JAMBOREE

To: School Principals and Administrators of Public and Private Elementary, Junior and Senior High Schools

1. Please be informed that the BSP Angeles City Council will hold its 16th City Wide Scout Jamboree with the theme "Saving Lives" on March 5-8, 2020 at Angeles University Foundation Integrated School, Barbara St, Marisol, Angeles City.
2. The objectives of the Jamboree are as follows:
 - a. To develop the values of brotherhood and camaraderie among scouts and scouters during their participation in the different scouting activities focused on how to save lives;
 - b. To encourage the scouts to use their abilities, talents, skills, resourcefulness and self-reliance in saving lives;
 - c. To gain an advancement in rank to qualify for the highest National Award.
3. The participants must possess the following qualifications:
 1. Must be a registered scout
 2. Must have an official neckerchief and slide
 3. Must be physically fit
 4. Must secure a parental consent
 5. Must be accompanied by a unit leader
4. Participation to this activity is on a voluntary basis.
5. A registration fee of four hundred pesos (P 400.00) shall be charged to each participant to cover the expenses for souvenir items (Neckerchief, passport advancement, I.D. Lace), trophies, certificates, program materials, food and snacks for the guests and staffs, and other operating expenses.
6. All concerned schools are expected to extend their full support to their students who have been selected to participate in the jamboree. In the same manner, they are hereby enjoined to comply with the mandates of Education Act of 1982, Rule III, Section 3, (e) that teachers shall refrain from making deductions in the scholastic rating of pupils/students, for any act that is clearly not a manifestation of poor scholarship and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, Paragraph 2, (b) uphold child protection policy principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form.



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7. Likewise, teachers involved in the event should prepare a self-learning module which consists of lessons, activities and exercises to compensate the lost number of school days and make necessary arrangements with their principals to ensure compliance with DepEd Order No. 9 s., 2005 entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and Strict Compliance with 180 days Teaching and Learning Guidelines".

8. Service Credits shall be granted as stipulated in DECS Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. Non-Teaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance to Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.

8. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
