DIVISION PRESENTATION OF LEARNING RECOVERY PLAN CUM ORIENTATION - WORKSHOP ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL LEARNING RECOVERY PLAN

1. The School Division of Angeles City has spearheaded the activity on the development of the learning recovery plan in preparation for the progressive expansion of face-to-face classes. The learning recovery plan aims to provide a strategic roadmap for improving the delivery of quality of basic education in all public schools by addressing the pandemic's immediate effects on learning and teacher-learner participation, closing access gaps, confronting the issue of education quality, anticipating the future of education, and introducing innovations in fostering resiliency and embedding children's and youth's rights in education.
