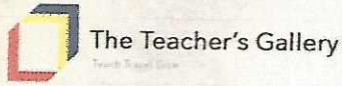

The two legislators were invited to present the joint bill to be joined by VP President Leni Robredo, UNICEF Deputy Representative Ms. Julia Rees, and SMX Vice President Annie Garcia in opening the event.

Renowned international experts in inclusive education are expected to provide the keynotes at the Summit, namely Dr. Tony Booth from the University of Cambridge, celebrated author of the Index to Inclusion (translated into 40 languages) and David Hoff of the Massachusetts based Institute for Community Inclusion. We have extraordinary people to tell their overcoming-disability-to succeed success stories. Schools, both public and private, parents, and service providers have been invited to share their best practices/perspectives on how inclusion works for their children.

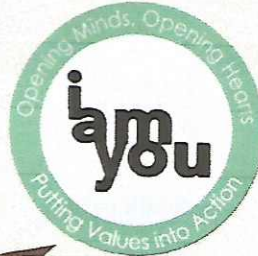

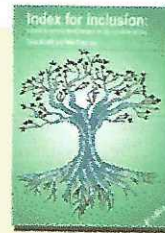
