The Camp aims to:

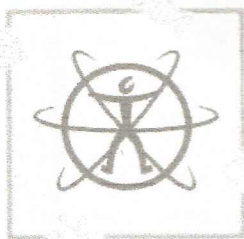

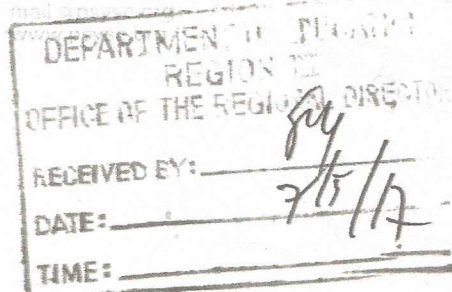
