

Speakers:

1. Dr. Christ Weemaes-Lidman (Belgium, Hong Kong)

Dr. Maria Christina Weemaes-Lidman or "Christ" has been an educator for twenty five years in many different countries and in an array of different positions, ranging from teacher, curriculum coordinator, lecturer, deputy principal and principal of several international schools. Currently, she is the Principal of Hong Kong University of Science and Technology's Campus Kindergarten.

Christ is an experienced, well qualified passionate educator and an inspiring lecturer. She was born in Sint-Niklaas, Belgium but is now a permanent Hong Kong resident and a licensed Hong Kong School Principal. She obtained her Doctor of Education degree from the Hong Kong Institute of Education. The title of her research is: "Educational Stakeholders' Perceptions of Holistic Education in Three Swedish Schools: Towards a Model of Holistic Education in Early Childhood". Christ has also a master's degree in Educational Leadership and Management as well as a post graduate degree in Early Childhood.

She has qualifications in Montessori, ESL, IPC and IB and she has participated in the design and establishment of new kindergartens in Sweden as well as being involved as a school advisor for curriculum, admission of students and recruitment of staff in Sweden, Korea and Hong Kong.

2. Sheila Wee (Singapore)

Sheila Wee has been a full-time professional storyteller for 17 years and has been described as a Godmother of Singapore storytelling. She co-founded Singapore's first storytelling circle, its first professional storytelling company and was instrumental in the development of the Asian Congress of Storytellers. She has been running a public introduction to Storytelling Course since 1999 and has taught, or mentored most of the storytellers now active in Singapore. She is founding professional member, past vice-president and past president of the Storytelling Association.

Sheila tells to adults, teens or children and she is adept at varying her storytelling style according to her audience. She is comfortable telling to small groups, or to audiences of over a thousand. Her storytelling has been described variously as warm, engaging, elegant and captivating.

Sheila's storytelling experiences has been deep and wide ranging and has included curating and performing exhibit specific performances for museums and training heritage guides. She has brought National Arts Council endorsed performances and workshop programmes to countless primary and secondary school students and has trained numerous teachers and lectures in the use of storytelling in their teaching.
