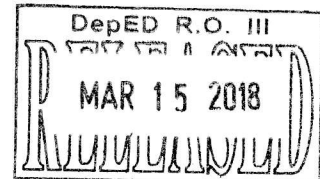

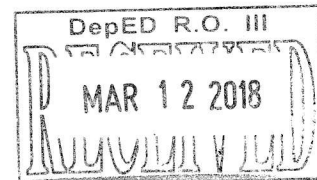

Greetings of peace from APNIEVE-Philippines!

The Asia Pacific Network for International and Values Education (APNIEVE-Philippines) will have its 17th National Convention and Teacher-Training Workshop on **April 18, 19, 20, 2018** at the **Holy Angel University, Angeles City, Pampanga**. The theme is **“Empowering Teachers towards Quality and Inclusive Values Education and International Education.”**

In this connection, may we request that the Department issue an advisory encouraging school officials and Social Sciences and Education teachers to attend this in-service training on official time using local school funds? This continuing professional education program is our modest contribution to the global campaign for peace, human rights, democracy and sustainable development. Teachers will also be exposed to the APNIEVE holistic teacher-learning cycle which is applicable across levels and subject areas.

The individual registration is P2, 500 which covers the individual membership for one year (P1,000) and the conference fee (P1,500 for 3 lunches and 6 snacks, materials and use of facilities) for the duration of the convention, excluding accommodations. An optional half-day heritage tour is being organized by HAU. Institutional membership per school is P5, 000.

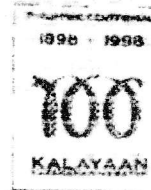


This is to certify that the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws of
