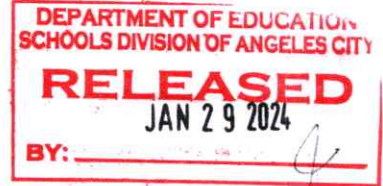

CONTEST GUIDELINES

ACADEMIC QUIZ (Elementary Level)

1. The contest is a written academic quiz with questions involving subject categories namely: Math, Science, English, Filipino, Philippine History and Current Events, Trivia and General Information.
2. The competition is composed of teams from various private and public elementary schools.
3. There shall be a maximum of five (5) bona fide Grade 6 contestants per school.

Three (3) students will be competing at a time; the other two (2) will serve as alternates of the three during level intervals.
4. The participants are requested to wear their respective school uniforms.
5. Calculators and cellphones are not allowed during the contest. Answers which require computations should be written with appropriate units.

6. The quiz consists of three rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult.
7. Seven (7) questions will be asked for each round.
8. Each question for the easy round is worth two (2) points, average is five (5) points, and difficult is ten (10) points.
9. Time limit for each question will be announced by the quizmaster.
10. Each question will be read twice by the quizmaster. Only when the quizmaster has said the word “go” are the teams allowed to discuss and write their answer.
11. Only the team captains are authorized to write and submit the answers.
12. The duly registered coaches and the team captains are authorized to make any protest. Other personalities apart from the aforementioned are not allowed to address a clarification or protest. All protests should be referred to the Board of Consultants before the quizmaster reads the next question.
13. The decision of the Board of Consultants is final.
14. The teams with the highest accumulated score will be declared the champion, the second highest – first runner-up, and the third highest- second runner-up.
15. In case of ties, clincher questions will be asked to break the tie on a sudden death basis.
16. Trophies will be awarded to the winning teams and certificates of participation will be given to all participants.



9. Substitution shall only be allowed at the end of each round.
10. The contest shall consist of the following levels with the corresponding points for every correct answer.

EASY ROUND	7 Questions	2 points
AVERAGE ROUND	7 Questions	5 points
DIFFICULT ROUND	7 Questions	10 points
11. After every round, the accumulated points shall be totaled. The teams with the highest accrued score will be declared the CHAMPION, the second highest – 1st runner-up, and the third highest- 2nd runner-up.
12. In case of ties, clincher questions will be asked to break the tie on a sudden death basis.
13. Any form of cheating will result to the disqualification of the team such as using electronic devices during the round proper and peeking at the work of other teams.
14. The decision of the Board of Consultants is final and irrevocable.
