As a testament to this mission, the School of Computing will again open its doors to aspiring college students to experience a day filled with fun and learning through an event entitled "A Day with the Foxes 2024".

Coinciding with this event, the yearly celebration of the Multimedia Arts Festival will also be held. This year, the festival is dubbed: "ANIRAYA 2024: Multimedia-Verse". It will highlight the School of Computing's various programs with the help of college-based organizations. This activity "**A Day in the life of an Angelite Fox**" is student centered and it gives an insight of what awaits them if they decide to make their best moments with Holy Angel University.

With this objective we have shared with you, we would like to invite your prestigious school and your students (preferably graduating Senior High School status) to attend the above-mentioned event. The event will run for two (2) days, divided into two (2) sessions and you have the option to choose which day and session you wish your students to attend. Below are the details of the event.

Details of the event:

A. Number of Students from Senior High School: 50 students coming from Grade 12 including the teacher-in-charge per session

The number of participants coming from different schools whom we will allow in every session is 50, the session will last for approximately three (3) hours.



- B. Date and Time: March 14-15 (Thursday Friday)
 - The event is set for two days, and each day is divided into two (2) sessions, one in the morning from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM and another one in the afternoon from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM. Additionally, the highlight of the **ANIRAYA** will be on the 2nd day (March 15). Kindly fill in the attached excel spreadsheet to choose from among the schedules available. - C. HAU Bus will be provided. Transportation will be available to pick and drop the students from your institution to ensure safety going to the university and going back to your institution as part of the HAU-SOC experience.
- **D. Venues on Campus:** SJH Academic Hall, and SJH 5th, 6th and 7th floor to tour the facilities and visit the exhibits. SJH academic hall has a capacity of around 300 students. For Organization booths and SOC experience tours in the SJH 5th, 6th and 7th floor, students will be guided by our ushers.

We believe that an event of this nature not only enhances our students' educational experience, but also strengthens the bond between our institutions. By combining our efforts, we can amplify the impact of this event and encourage a larger number of students to participate and take advantage of this exceptional opportunity.
