With the theme *Pulso: Ritmo ng Pag-asa*, this year's **MedCon Case Competition is a HYBRID, two-round, and senior high school (SHS) level competition** that aims to develop the participants' problem-solving and public speaking skills by proposing a feasible, relevant, and health-oriented solution for the partner community, Unilab Foundation.

Thus, we humbly ask your office if the MedCon Case Competition 2024 can be disseminated to the respective senior high schools under your respective region. We believe that this event is a great way for SHS students to broaden their horizon towards the field of medicine and public health. This is a great opportunity for students who might be interested in this event so they can join!

The event is open for all SHS students with a registration fee of Php 30.00 for individual registrants or Php 150.00 for each team (composed of 3 to 5 SHS students) that will cover access to training resources and free mentorship.

There will also be cash prizes for the top three winners. Here are the cash prizes as follows:

- 1st Place Php 5,000.00
- 2nd Place Php 3,000.00
- 3rd Place Php 2,000.00

Case Competition

MedCon 2024 continues with a senior high school level competition where participants will undergo training sessions towards crafting innovative, youth-led, and community-oriented health solutions for a case provided by the partner entity. Sessions begin with an online setup and culminate in an in-person presentation.

About MedCon - Case Competition

The event will be composed of two rounds, a Preliminary Round and Final Round. Training sessions will be held before each round to guide the participants on how to approach the problem. Submission entries will be evaluated by veteran PMS members and representatives from our case partner

This experience will allow you to hone your skills in collaboration, critical thinking, public speaking, and problem solving.

Together, you will make history as participants of one of the country's first ever high-school level medical case competitions. You will be provided with opportunities to form lasting bonds with your peers as the next generation of health professionals.

Registration Guidelines

- The pitch competition is open to public and private high schools in the Philippines.
 Please note that:
 - a. The training sessions and preliminary round will be held online.
 - b. The final round will be held face-to-face in Metro Manila.
- 2. Each school can send multiple teams composed of 3 to 5 Grade 11 to 12 high school students.
- 3. Students may also register individually and be grouped together by the organizers with other individual registrants to form a team of 3 to 5.
- 4. The registration fee for groups will be Php 150 whereas for individual participants it will be Php 30. The fee consists of the following inclusions:
 - a. Access to training sessions
 - b. Mentorship from case partner representatives and/or PMS Management Board

- 6. The registration period will be from March 18, 2024 to April 24, 2024. The organizers will not be accepting participants who apply after the set deadline.
- 7. Online synchronous events will primarily take place using Zoom, participants must have the application downloaded and updated.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Are college students allowed to participate in the Medcon Case Competition?
 - a. The Medcon Case Competition is open to Grade 11 and 12 students only.
- 2. Where can non-participants view the Medcon Case Competition?
 - a. The final round of the Medcon Case Competition will be held face-to-face (Venue: TBA). Admission to watch the final round will be open for close family and friends of the participants. Further details will be provided soon.
- 3. Are training sessions open to the public?
 - a. The training sessions are closed-door sessions. They are only available for confirmed participants of the Medcon Case Competition
- 4. Does a group need to come from the same batch and/or school?
 - a. Participants may come from different schools and batches provided that the team is composed of 3 to 5 Grade 11 to 12 students.
- 5. Are minors allowed to participate in the Medcon Case Competition?
 - a. Minors are allowed to participate in the MedCon Case Competition. Regardless of age, participants are advised to have a legal guardian, mentor, or adviser to complete the registration process for them and guide them throughout the competition.
- 6. Should I come from a STEM or Allied Health track to participate?
 - a. The MedCon Case Competition is open to all Grade 11 and 12 students, regardless of track. Teams may also be composed of students from different senior high school tracks.
- 7. How will the competition be conducted?
 - a. The Preliminary Round will entail a submission of a 3-page canvas of the competing team's proposed solution, along with a 2-minute elevator pitch to be posted on the team member's personal Facebook accounts. The entries will then be screened and evaluated by the panel of judges which will be composed of case partner representatives and PMS Management Board affiliates. The Top 5 proposals will be proceeding to the Final Round.
 - b. The Final Round will be held face-to-face (Venue: Alcantara Hall, SUB, UP Diliman). The teams will present their case solutions live to a panel of judges. Prior to the event, the Top 5 finalists should have submitted a copy of their visual aids and presentation outlines. A 15-minute Question and Answer session will be held after the presentations. Questions will come from the panel and the audience.
 - c. The MedCon Case Competition will consist of two training sessions, a Preliminary Round, and a Final Round. The Preliminary Round will be conducted asynchronously, while the training sessions and Final Round will take place synchronously. The synchronous training and mentoring sessions will be conducted through Zoom, and are open only to confirmed participants of the MedCon Case Competition. The first training session will take place before the Preliminary Round. The Top 5 finalists will be given a mentorship

Medical Convention 2024: Case Competition General Mechanics

The Medical Convention (MedCon) Case Competition is a blended inter-high school level competition that aims to challenge the participants' problem-solving and public speaking skills by proposing a feasible and relevant health-oriented solution for our case partner.

The event will be composed of two rounds: a Preliminary Round and a Final Round. Training sessions will be held before each round to guide the participants on how to properly formulate their solutions to the case brief.

Registration Guidelines

- The pitch competition is open to ALL public and private high schools in the Philippines.
- 2. Each school can send multiple teams composed of 3 to 5 Grade 11 to 12 high school students.
- 3. Students can register **individually** and be placed together by the Organizers with other individual registrants to form a team of 3 to 5.
- 4. The registration fee will be Php 150 for each team or Php 30 for individual registrants, which will have the following inclusions:
 - a. Access to training sessions and resource drive
 - b. Mentorship from case partner representatives and/or PMS Management Board

- 6. The registration period will be from **March 18, 2024 to April 24, 2024**. The organizers will NOT be accepting late registrations.
- 7. For synchronous events that will take place using Zoom, the participants must have the application downloaded and updated.

Zoom Decorum

- 1. During synchronous events throughout the competition proper, the participants are expected to be inside the Zoom meeting at least 5 minutes before the indicated time.
- 2. Please stay muted and keep your cameras off if it is not your team presenting to avoid distractions and interruptions.
 - a. Privately send a message to any event organizer present in the Zoom meeting if you have any concerns or difficulties.
 - Use the raise hand feature for any questions and wait to be acknowledged before speaking.
- 3. Participants are encouraged to wear appropriate attires when presenting.
 - a. Preferably yellow-colored formal attire or collared tops

4. Before entering the Zoom meeting, please change your display name to the following format: [Team Name] - Last Name, First Name

Training Session Guidelines

- 1. There will be two (2) Training Sessions (TS) for the case competition.
 - a. TS 1 will be held ONLINE on April 27, 2024 (Saturday) from 10:00 AM 12:00 NN.
 - b. TS 2 will be held ONLINE on May 11, 2024 (Saturday) from 10:00 AM 12:00 NN.
- 2. For TS 1, the participants will be attending a two-hour seminar by public health experts and youth social innovators.
 - The participants will be able to learn the fundamentals of design thinking and health program design.
- 3. For TS 2, the top 5 teams will be connected to a specific mentor to refine their final proposal and pitch skills.
 - Mentors will be sourced from case partner representatives or PMS Management Board affiliates.

Preliminary Round Guidelines

- 1. The following are to be submitted:
 - a. A 3-paged canvas of their proposed solution
 - i. The paper can be written in either English or Filipino. Code-switching is NOT allowed in the proposal.
 - b. A 2-minute elevator pitch of their proposed solutions to be posted on the MedCon 2024 Case Competition Participants Facebook group.
 - The proponents may speak in English and/or Filipino. Code-switching is accepted in the elevator pitch.
- 2. The deadline for submission and posting of the pitch video will be on May 4, 2024 (Saturday) at 11:59 PM.
- The entries will then be screened and evaluated by the panel of judges which will be composed of case partner representatives and PMS Management Board affiliates. The Top 5 proposals will be proceeding to the Final Round.
- 4. Further details regarding the next round will be sent to the finalists through email.

Final Round Guidelines

- 1. The final round will be held face-to-face on May 18, 2024, from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM (Venue: Room 423, Student Union Building).
- 2. A copy of the finalists' visual aids and presentation outline must be submitted via email before the presentation for the Final Round.
 - a. Participants may submit in .pdf or .pptx formats

- 3. The presentation must not exceed the time limit of 15 minutes.
- 4. The participants may speak in English or Filipino, but not both. Code-switching is NOT permitted.
- 5. After the presentation, a 15-minute Question and Answer session will be held, wherein the panel and the audience will be asking questions to the participants regarding the proposed solution.

Awards and Prizes

- 1. All competition participants, regardless of placement, will be conferred *Certificates of Participation*.
 - For distinction, the winner, finalists, and special award recipients (if any) will be conferred separate certificates.
- Additional documentation of the event may be requested from the organizers for application requirements (e.g., university applications). Kindly send your requests to <u>careerandacads@uppremedsoc.org</u> with the subject "[Team Name] - Case Competiton Documentation Request".
- 3. The winning participants will receive cash prizes to be ideally used for the funding of their proposed solutions.

4. The organizers will be keeping in contact with teams interested in implementing their campaigns or projects for any necessary assistance and documentation, which will be released through official PMS channels.





The Medical Convention (MedCon) Case Competition is a blended, two-round, and senior high school SHS) level competition that combines problem-solving and public speaking challenges, where participants propose practical and pertinent health solutions for our case partner.

- 1. The case competition is open to ALL public and private senior high schools in the Philippines.
- 2. Senior high school students can apply solo or in teams of 3 to 5. If applying individually, the organizers will create teams of 3 to 5 based on the number of confirmed entries.
- 3. The registration fee is Php 150 per team or Php 30 per individual, which includes access to training sessions, a resource drive, and mentorship from case partner representatives and/or PMS Management Board.
