KAB HOLIDAY

To: School Principals and Administrators of Public and Private Elementary Schools

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines –Angeles City Council will hold KAB HOLIDAY on October 26, 2024, Saturday (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) at Angeles University Foundation Integrated School, Santa Barbara Campus, Marisol Subd., Ninoy Aquino, Angeles City with the theme: **"KAB: GAWING MASAYA ANG BUHAY."**

- 2. The activity aims:
 - a. to provide avenue for the KAB scouts:
 - b. to meet their fellow scouts and to foster sportsmanship's and camaraderie:
 - c. show off their talents in dancing:
 - d. boost their self- confidence through their performances in front of the crowd:
 - e. display sportsmanship in defeat; and
 - f. Apply the KAB Scouts Promise and Law.
- 3. Participants must be:
 - a. a registered scout:
 - b. have a original neckerchief and slide
 - c. have a parental consent
 - d. be accompanied by adult leader

3. A registration fee of **Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 250.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for program materials, certificates, trophies, bag, venue, tarpaulin and other miscellaneous expenses.

4. Participation of the teachers and learners shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper the instructional time in compliance with the provision of DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024, and DO No. 9 s. 2005 titles Instituting Measures to Increase off –campus activities stated in the DO 66, 2017.

6. Transportation and other expenses going to and from the venue shall be charged to the account of the participants and contingent.

7. Immediate dissemination of the content of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.

Guidelines - Philippine Dance Festival - KABSAYAHAN 2024

- 1. All participants must be duly registered Kab Scout.
- 2. All participants institution must submit list of participants.
- 3. Participants are required to secure parental consent.
- 4. The Scout Leader and Scouts will be responsible for the preparation for the theme and materials needed during the event.
- 5. The theme of the KABSAYAHAN is Philippine Dance Festival
- 6. Each group shall compose of a minimum 16 and maximum of 32 Kab Scouts
- 7. Costumes should adhere to Type B or C as per the Kab Scout uniform guidelines.
- 8. The group must wear a headdress as part of their costume.
- 9. The order of the performance will be based on the number they had picked prior to the contest.

10. Group must save the music in a Flash drive/cellphone. There should be a back-up copy in case the submitted music fails to play.

11. Use of props will be allowed if it will not cause any delay in the program and those that may harm other groups such as sharp objects and fire are prohibited.

- 10. No professional dancers or trainers are allowed to "shadow teach" during the performance only Scout Leaders.
- 11. Music and choreography should be wholesome and lively. Must not contain any subliminal and vulgar lyrics / language or suggestive act.
- 12. The performance must be at least 3 minutes but not more than 5 minutes. Any excess in time will have 3 points deduction / min total score. However, each group will be given 2 minutes to prepare / set up any props or equipment 's needed on stage/ performing area.
- 13. All participants should conduct a manner displaying good sportsmanship's throughout the competition.
- 14. The criteria for the judging are as follows:

Technique, Skill, and Choreography	30%
Artistry and Expression:	30%
Cultural Authenticity and Representation	20%
Costume and Presentation	20%
Total	100%

Craftsmanship and Quality	20 %
Total	100%

Dance Festival – Best Scout Leader Choreographer

Effectiveness in communicating choreographic concepts and	35%
techniques to dancers	
Artistic Expression, Interpretation and Audience Impact	30%
Total	100%

- 15. Winners will be selected based on their overall performance, creativity, and adherence to the guidelines. Awards will be given to the Champion, First Runner Up, and Second Runner Up.
- 16. Special Awards will be given for Best Headdress and Best Leader Choreographer.
- 17. The decision of judges is final and irrevocable.
