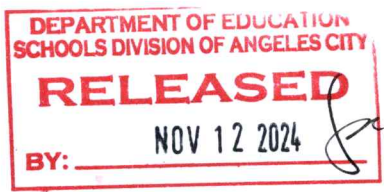

We are the Samahan ng mga Mag-aaral sa Komunikasyon (AMF SAMASKOM), the official non-mandated organization of the Department of Communication at Angeles University Foundation. The Media Congress is still dated tentatively by next year.

The Media Caravan, themed "Beyond the Awareness," is a two-day event aimed to introduce students to the AB Communication Program. Another is the Media Congress, organized by both SAMASKOM and The Pioneer, the official university publication of Angeles University Foundation. This is a journalism seminar wherein a renowned speaker from the field will be invited to talk about pressing issues. Lastly is the journalism skills training to be conducted by The Lightkeepers, the official college publication of the Arts and Sciences of the university; this is where the editorial staff of said publication will conduct a writing seminar for the schools' chosen participants.
