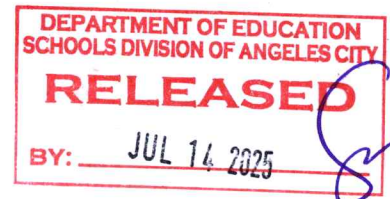

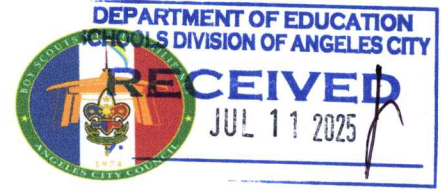

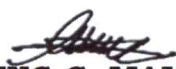
ORIENTATION ON THE BSP NATIONAL SAFEGUADING POLICY
