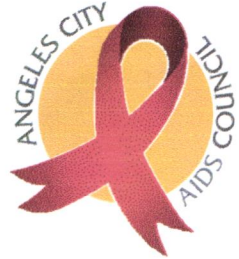

### DETAILED MECHANICS

1. The contest is open to all Senior High School students.
2. Registration period: **November 17-27, 2025** – 8-5pm.

3. Participants will be given 2 hours to finish their work at the venue site.
4. The following materials (provided by the participant) will be used:
  - ¼ Illustration board
  - Coloring material: oil pastel
5. Entries should illustrate, interpret and emphasize this year's World AIDS Day  
**Theme: "Overcoming Disruption, Transforming the AIDS Response"**
6. All entries must be original works of the participant. Participant will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
7. Winning and all other entries shall be the property of the Angeles City AIDS Council and may be used for other advocacy activities.
8. The winning entry will be determined by the following criteria:

Relevance to the theme	- 30%
Creativity and Originality	- 30%
Quality (composition, design elements and color)	- 20%
Overall Artistic Impression	- <u>20%</u>
	100%
9. There will be three (3) winners for the contest: 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 1<sup>st</sup> Place. Each will receive cash prize.
