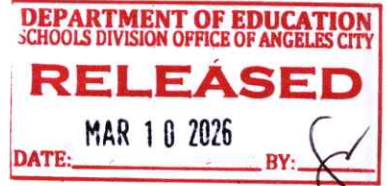

- 1 *The Boys Scouts of the Philippines- Angeles City Council will conduct 2026 Council Scout Youth Forum on March 13-15 ,2026 at BSP Training Center, Sto. Domingo, Angeles City*
- 2 *The Scout Youth Forum, a part pf Youth Development Program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is organized to fill in the need and the clamor for youth participation in the decision-making process in the Scout Movement. It is a placed for information, training, and concrete experience of discussing and acquiring a deeper understanding of various issues. It is also a source of inspiration by providing contact with new people, fresh ideas, innovative thoughts, different experiences, and working method*
- 3 *General Qualification. For individual to qualify to participate in a Scout Youth Forum, the following standard must be met:*
  - a. *Must be currently registered Senior Scout*
  - b. *Must have a official Scout Uniform (Type: "A")*
  - c. *Must have parental consent*
  - d. *Must be a pathfinder rank*
  - e. *Must be accompanied by one (1) Adult Leader*
- 4 *Each participating schools must send at least 5 delegates (2 voting delegate and 3 observer)*
5. *Elections: There are only Two (2) required elections in the Scout Youth Forum:*
  1. *The elections for the forum official otherwise known as the Steering Committee and;*
  2. *The election of the Scout Representative to represent the Boy scouts of the Philippines- Angeles City Council to the Regional Scout Forum to be held at Tarlac Council on March 17-19, 2026*
- 6 *Participants are required to bring the following:*
  - a. *Pack dinner*
  - b. *Type A. Uniform*
  - c. *Plate, mug, spoon, fork, bowl*
  - d. *Extra white T/shirt*
