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UP AGUMAN'S CEER

The **College Entrance Examination Review (CEER)** is an annual review session dedicated to help graduating senior high school students from Pampanga as they soon embark on their journey towards college. One of the main goals of this event is to impart learnings and valuable experiences to fellow Kapampangans by simulating how an actual college entrance examination would play out, particularly that of the coveted University of the Philippines College Admission Test (UPCAT).

CEER FROM THE PREVIOUS YEARS

With over 1000 reviewees every year (2000+ reviewers for CEER 2022), UP Aguman's CEER has returned from the new normal set-up with two whole-day weekend review sessions around May to June. It is composed of two parts, the **mock examination** in the morning, and the **review proper** in the afternoon.

The **mock examination** in the morning is where students would be given time to answer supplementary booklets containing questions coming from different fields of knowledge, all of which are catered to be similar to what is found on common college entrance examinations.

In the afternoon, the **review proper** is administered, where invited instructors or professors from the University of the Philippines would discuss the answers to the questions in the questionnaire and allot time for the students' queries regarding the exam. They are also expected to share additional knowledge that the students must further know, which may not have appeared in the mock exam questionnaire. The discussion part of the review would be divided into different subjects such as Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Vocabulary, etc., to ensure that all subjects of interest would be covered.
