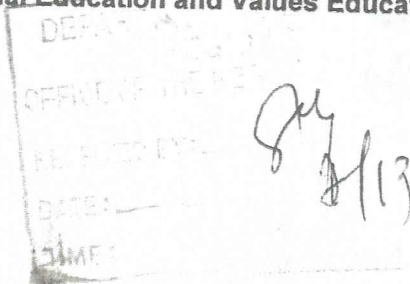

The Asia-Pacific Network for International Education and Values Education, Philippines, aims to promote and develop international education and values education for peace, human rights, democracy, and sustainable development through networking and cooperation among individuals and institutions in the country.

On April 26 to 28, 2017, APNIEVE will hold its 16th Annual National Convention with the theme "In Pursuit of Quality Education, the Past, Present and Future" at the University of Northern Philippines, Barangay Tamag, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur. 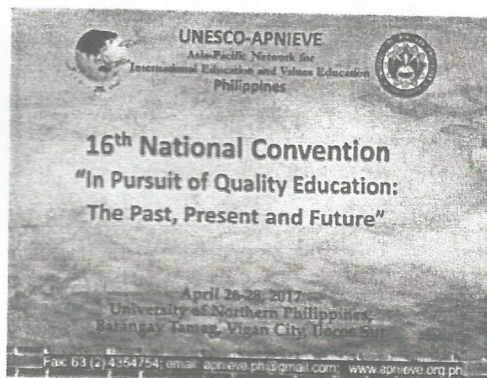
