REGIONAL BOOSTER-TRAINING ON CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPERVISION FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPALS

1. Benchmarking from the Re-Entry Action Plans of Senior High School Principals during their School Heads' Development Program last June 2016 at the NEAP-III (formerly RELC), Pulungbulu, Angeles City, this Office announces that a Regional Booster-Training on Curriculum and Instructional Supervision for Senior High School Principals shall be conducted on the following schedule:

2. This three-day training primordially aims to:
- enhance their knowledge of the core, applied and specialized subjects in the Senior High School;
 - broaden their understanding on the learning competencies per subject including the code and code book legend, and the content/performance standard ;
 - strengthen their capability in providing technical assistance (TA) to teachers in action research;
 - develop skills in addressing the learning assessment gaps, in organizing TIP/SLACs for teachers particularly the new ones, and in the use of CAI; and
 - upgrade their level of confidence and competence in instructional leadership and supervision.
3. Participants to the training are the 458 Senior High School Principals who attended the Modules I and II during the School Heads' Development Program conducted by the Region last year. Since this is a booster-training, substitution of participant or sending a proxy is "strongly discouraged".
4. The food and accommodation of the Regional facilitators/staff and the SDO participants shall be charged against HRTD funds of the Region, while travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Drivers are not included in the accommodation.
5. The participants are requested to bring their own laptops, a copy of Curriculum Guide and Teacher's Guide for the Grade 11 course offerings to be used during the training.. Enclosed is the training matrix for reference.
6. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
