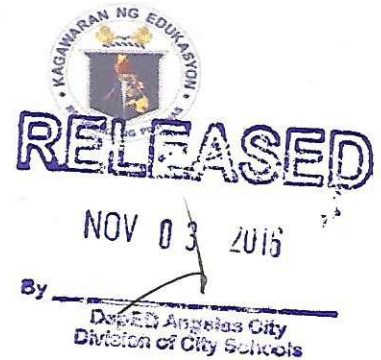

**SCHOOL/CLASSROOM—BASED OBSERVANCE OF FILIPINO VALUES MONTH
CELEBRATION**

TO: *All Public Elementary and Secondary/IS School Heads*
All EsP Head Teachers / Coordinators
All EsP District Leaders

1. As stipulated in the Enclosure No. 3 to DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2016 – Activities and/or Observances Mandated by Law, **FILIPINO VALUES MONTH** is observed every November. Relative to this, all schools are mandated to conduct school/classroom-based activities in celebration of the Filipino Values Month this November 2016.
2. Schools have the option to come up with their own theme and activities like quiz bee, poster-making, essay writing contest, search for outstanding EsP students and teachers, symposia, seminars, etc. which are anchored on the promotion and preservation of the innate Filipino Values of **MAKADIYOS** (faith, religiosity, love, charity...), **MAKATAO** (respect, life, dignity, justice...), **MAKABANSA**(patriotism, nationalism, freedom, responsibility...) and **MAKAKALIKASAN** (responsible dominion, care & preservation of environment...)
3. Schools are encouraged to continue and strengthen the implementation of their **CREEDS** for their students on Good Manners and Right Conduct and Project: **MABUTING GURO** (creed of the Filipino Teachers) which are recited during Flag Ceremonies, EsP Classes and Teachers' Meetings. Installation of posters of the said creeds in the various strategic places inside the school is likewise encouraged.
4. Write-up, pictures, videos or other proofs of utilization of the school's Best Localized Modules, Video Lessons, Instructional Materials and Teaching Strategies in EsP and a Narrative Report of the school's observance of this Filipino Values Month Celebration shall be submitted to the EPS 1 of EsP at the end of November 2016.
5. The No Disruption of Classes Policy is maintained in relation to this celebration.
