Subject: **2016 WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION**

Date: **February 19, 2016**

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 224, s. 1988 declaring the first week of March each year as Women's Week and March 8 as Women's Rights and International Peace Day; Proclamation No. 227 s. 1988 providing for the observance of the Month of March as Women's Role in History Month and Republic Act (RA) 6949 s. 1990 declaring March 8 of every year as National Women's Day, this Division will conduct various school-based activities to celebrate the diverse and historic accomplishments of women.
2. In view thereof, the following are suggested school-based activities for this year's Women's Month Celebration with the theme "**Kapakanan ni Juana, Isama sa Agenda!**":
 - March 7 (Monday) – Conduct a brief lecture after the Flag Ceremony about "Famous Women in the Philippines and their Achievements"
 - March 4 (Friday) - Physical Fitness/Wellness Activities
 - March 11 (Friday) - Personality Development
 - March 18 (Friday) - Relaxation and Recreation
3. All activities will be held in the afternoon of every Friday, except for the brief lecture, to avoid disruption of classes.
4. Expenses incidental to the conduct of the different activities can be charged from the 5% of the school MOOE which is intended for Gender and Development.

5. A narrative and pictorial report shall be submitted in soft and hard copy. For uniformity, hard copy shall be printed in the legal size bond paper duly signed by responsible officials. Soft copy shall be sent via email at SGOD.DEPEDAC@gmail.com
