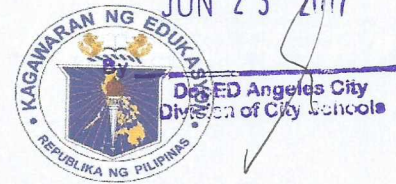



1. In consonance with the Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), Division Training-Workshop on Contextualizing Support System for Indigenous Peoples Education and Division Retooling for Teachers and School Heads for Indigenous Peoples will be conducted on June 29, 2017 1t Gabaldon Bldg., Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
