B. MECHANICS OF THE ACTIVITIES

On The Spot Poster Making Contest

How to join

1. The On the Spot Poster Making contest is open to grade 5 pupils and grade 8 students from public elementary and secondary schools.
- 2 The school principal will submit the names of the participant to Mr. Dennis M. Bautista on November 20 – 22, 2017 for registration.

Mechanics

1. The poster should be a visualization of the 2017 National Book Week Theme “LIBRARIES TAKE ACTION: PROVIDING ACCESS AND OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL”.
2. Use white illustration board, 15” x 20 “in size.
3. Contestant may use any medium (craypas, water color, crayon, pentel pen, etc.)
4. The contestant’s name and school must be written on a separate sheet of paper and stapled or attached at the back of the entry.
5. Contestant will be given 1 hour and 30 minutes to finish the activity.
6. The Judge will select best 3 winners.
7. The winners will be given certificates.
8. The non winning participants will receive certificate of participation.
9. Coaches will also receive certificates.

Judging:

1. Entries will be judged by the Education supervisor in Mapeh.
2. Criteria for judging will be as follows:

•	Relevance to the theme	40 %
•	Creativity	25 %
•	Visual Impact	20 %
•	Originality	15 %

How to Join

Mechanics

1. The on the spot essay writing contest will be held at Library Hub, Conference Room.
2. The essay will focus on the theme of the National Book Week 2017 celebration which is "LIBRARIES TAKE ACTION: PROVIDING ACCESS AND OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL".
3. The essay should be written in English, not be more than 300 words, handwritten.
4. Bring Mongol pencil.
5. The judges will select 3 winners.
6. The criteria for judging will be as follows:

• Organization	– 35 %
• Content	– 35 %
• Mechanics	– 30 %
Total	100 %
7. The winners will be given certificates.
8. The non - winning participants will receive certificate of participation.
9. Coaches will also receive certificates.
