SUBJECT : MECHANICS OF CONTESTS FIRE PREVENTION MONTH OBSERVANCE CY 2016

DATE : 04 MARCH 2016

Reference: Memorandum from FIRE DIRECTOR ARIEL A BARAYUGA, CEO VI, Chief, BFP dated 05 February 2016 re: above subject.

I. GENERAL STATEMENT

In order to have a unified mechanics in the conduct of this year's fire prevention contests, the following set of rules are to be observed in the Provincial Office, Regional Office including the National Headquarters.

II. SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY

This mechanics shall cover the following contests:

- a. Drawing contest – For Elementary Students;
- b. Essay Writing Contest – For Secondary Students;
- c. Photo Contest – Open to all Amateur Photographers;
- d. Poster Making Contest – For Secondary Students; and
- e. Ballroom Dancing Contest – Open to BFP personnel only.

III. OBJECTIVES

- a. To establish categorical rules, criteria and procedures on the conduct of CY 2016 Fire Prevention Month Contests; and
- b. To ensure fairness, objectivity and integrity of the contests.

IV. MECHANICS

1. The City/Municipal Fire Marshals, in coordination with the Local Chief Executives (LCE) shall seek the assistance of school officials by facilitating the participation of interested students. Likewise, posting of streamers in their stations for widest dissemination of the events is highly encouraged.

2. Entries shall strictly observe the following set of mechanics and criteria

a) Drawing Contest – Open to Elementary pupils

Mechanics:

- Must be drawn/illustrated in a 12 x 18 inches illustration board using either crayons or pastel to be provided by the BFP;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- No identifying marks shall be allowed in all entries;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size for exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said drawing/illustration; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and unappeasable.

Criteria for Judging	Rating
Theme Relevance Does the drawing/illustration effectively communicate the CY 2016 Fire Prevention Month theme?	40%
Creativity and Originality Does the drawing/illustration demonstrate creativity and originality?	30%
Aesthetic Appeal Does the drawing/illustration captivate the judge's sense, taking into account the principle of symmetry, focal point, pattern, perspective, dimensionality and proportion?	30%
Over-all Impression	100%

b) Essay Writing Contest – Open to Secondary students

Mechanics:

- Must be written (handwritten) in a yellow pad paper using black ball pen to be provided by the BFP;
- Composition must not exceed 750 words and must be written in English;
- All entries must have relevance with this year's Fire Prevention Month Theme/Slogan;
- Each participant should fill up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All participants are required to submit a photocopy of their school ID;
- The BFP has the right to publish the winning entry on its official gazette; and

Criteria for Judging	Rating
Theme Relevance Does it demonstrate a clear understanding of the theme? Does it clearly relate to the topic? Is it accurate and logical?	40%
Presentation and Persuasion Is the grammar, spelling and punctuation correct? Is the article neatly written and has well-constructed paragraphs?	30%
Creativity and Persuasion Does the article demonstrate creativity and originality? Does the essay inspires the reader and move them to action?	30%
Over-all Impression	100%

c) **Photo Contest – Open to all Amateur photographer**

Mechanics:

- Must be submitted in "8 x "10 or 8R full color print together with digital file or JPEG format (CD or E-mail at opn_r3@yahoo.com.ph)
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the drawing entry which shall be attached at the back of their entry;
- All entries must be taken in the Philippines and must not be digitally edited or augmented;
- All submitted entries shall become sole and exclusive property of the BFP and may be reproduced and/or reprinted into any size for exhibition without seeking permission from the owner or paying compensation for the acquisition of said photos; and
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and unappeasable.

Criteria for Judging	Rating
Theme Relevance Does the photo effectively communicate the CY 2016 Fire Prevention Month theme?	40%
Composition Are the items of interest placed well in the photo?	20%
Creativity Does the photo demonstrate originality and uniqueness?	20%
Technical Quality Is the photo in focus? Is lighting in balance?	20%
Over-all Impression	100%

d) **Poster Making Contest – Open to Secondary students**

Mechanics:

- Must be drawn/illustrated in a 12 x 18 inches illustration board using water color to be provided by the BFP;
- Each participant should fill-up the entry form provided by the BFP containing among others the following: full name, address, age, gender, telephone number and title and brief description of the

3rd Prize – 5,000.00

For ballroom dancing contest:

1st Prize – 15,000.00

2nd Prize – 10,000.00

3rd Prize – 5,000.00
