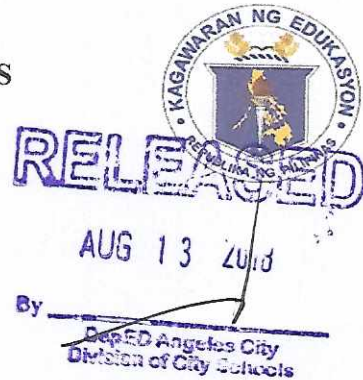



**DIVISION ADVOCACY CAMPAIGN OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION (IPEd) WITH STAKEHOLDERS AND PRODUCTION OF AUDIO VISUAL PRESENTATION ON THE INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS (IPEd) OF THE DEPARTMENT.**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10689 an Act declaring **August 9**, as National Indigenous Peoples Day and mandating the meaningful observance thereof, and Presidential Proclamation No. 1906, s. 2009 entitled Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as National Indigenous Peoples Month, the Department of Education (DepEd) enjoins all its offices and school to observe the said national celebrations, through various commemorative and advocacy activities. The department promotes inclusive education that recognizes the diversity of our learners in the country. In support of this mandate, the division will conduct the **“Division Advocacy Campaign of IPEd with Stakeholders and Production of Audio Visual Presentation on the Inclusive Education Programs (IPEd) of the Department”** on August 16, 2018 at Sitio Target Integrated School. The theme for this year’s observance is **“Ugnayan ng DepEd at Pamanayan Pagtibayin sa Pangalawang Decada ng Pagsulong sa Katutubong Edukasyon.”**
2. The objectives of this activities are:
  - a. To inform and educate stakeholders of the Inclusive Programs of DepEd like IPEd through the production of Audio Visual presentation materials;
  - b. To promote awareness and respect for indigenous cultural communities particularly those within the proximity of the school vicinity;
  - c. To strengthen the relationship of the IP communities and DepEd with other stakeholders like the LGUs and NGOs through the advocacy campaigns and activities of teaching and non-teaching personnel;
  - d. To hang banners and streamers in strategic places in the vicinity of DepEd and schools.
3. Participants to this advocacy are the Central Office, Regional Office, CID, SGOD, Principals with IP Learners, LGUs, NGOs, IP Elders/Leaders, CAB Members, Teacher-Writers and IP Learners.
4. Registration fee and meals shall be charged to the IPEd PSF subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The refreshments of pupils is chargeable to the school funds.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
