DEVELOPMENT AND VALIDATION OF CONTEXTUALIZED LESSON PLANS IN GRADES 2 TO 6 FOR AYTA MAG-ANTSI WITH THE ELDERS

1. The Enhanced Basic Education Program, as stipulated in Republic Act No. 10533 and the IPED provision of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 8.4), mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized, and flexible enough to enable and allow schools to localize, indigenize, and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities.
2. In support of this mandate, the Division will conduct the Development and Validation of Contextualized Lesson Plans in Grades 2 to 6 for Ayta Mag-Antsi with the Elders on **November 28-29, 2018 at Sapang Bato Elementary School, Sapang Bato, Angeles City**. The indigenized curriculum will be the basis for developing indigenized lesson plans which will guide teachers in facilitating a culture-based and culture-responsive teaching-learning process.
3. The objectives of the project are:
 - a) To develop the competencies needed in contextualizing the curriculum responsive to the indigenous community being served;
 - b) To develop the indigenized lesson plans for Grade 2 to 6 on the 3 subjects (Araling Panlipunan, MTB-MLE, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao) based on the contextualized curriculum for IPED;
4. Participants in this training are the Education Program Supervisors (Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, Kindergarten, and Filipino), Public Schools District Supervisors (Cluster 8-9, MTB-MLE and IPED Focal Person), Principals (Sapangbato ES and Cuayan ES), Teacher-Writers of IPED and Elders of Ayta Mag-Antsi.
5. Registration fee, meals and honorarium of elders relative to this training shall be charged to the IPED Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
