REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SPORTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

1. It is the policy of the state to promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry.

2. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 10588, entitled " An Act Institutionalizing the Conduct of Palarong Pambansa and Appropriating Funds Therefor" and as per Joint Circular (JC) No. 1, s. 2017, Section 3.0, Legal Bases on the Use of the SEF, the Department of Education (DepEd) Division of Angeles City together with the ACAA Board, hereby set the following Requirements and Specifications in the Implementation of Sports Development Programs:

- Sport Development Program covers the different sports programs and amateur sports activities such as: District, Public High and Private School Meets, City Division Amateur Athletic Association Meet, Participation to Regional Meet, and Participation to National Meet.
- Schools whose students are to participate in the amateur sports may receive the following incentives which will be charged against the Special Education Fund (SEF) under the Sports Development Program:
 - a. Uniform
 - b. Sports equipment/goods
 - c. Cash incentives
 - d. Supplemental allowance
 - e. Meals/meal allowance
 - f. Training allowance
 - g. Transportation allowance
 - h. Cash awards
 - i. Provision of drugs and medicines
 - j. Other incentives as may be determined by the ACAA Board.

3. Immediate and wide dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
