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**PATROL LEADERS TRAINING COURSE**

To: Heads of Public and Private Elementary Schools

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines , Angeles City Council will conduct Patrol Leaders Training Course on August 23-25, 2019 ( Friday to Sunday ) at the BSP Training Center, Angeles City with the theme: " Commitment to Excellence ."
2. **The objectives of the Course are as follows:**
  - A. Demonstrate typical Boy Scout activities and the need for intelligent coordination of effort through leadership;
  - B. Underline the necessity of discipline and good order;
  - C. Demonstrate the technique of learning through doing by immediate application of newly acquired Scouting Skill;
  - D. Direct the Patrol Leaders attention in a most practical way;
  - E. Give Scouts the experience of leadership;
  - F. To train boys to become effective leaders in their respective schools.
3. **GENERAL QUALIFICATION:** For an individual to qualify to participate in the Patrol Leaders Training Course, the following standards must be met.
  - A. Must be a currently registered Boy Scout.
  - B. Must be accompanied by their respected Troop Leader
  - C. Must be a Grade 4-6 pupil
  - D. Must have an official neckerchief and slide
  - E. Must be physically fit.
  - F. Must have parental consent.
4. The participants are required to bring the following:
  - A. Tent
  - B. Personal gear, white T-shirt, extra t-shirt ,rubber shoes , slipper
  - C. Toiletries, personal effects, off lotion
  - D. Spoon, Pork, Plate, Plastic Glass
5. **PARTICIPATION:** Each sponsoring institution must send at least minimum of 6 and maximum of 9 and must be potential Patrol Leaders. Participants are required to report at the venue on August 23, 2019, Friday at 1:00 PM.
6. **REGISTRATION FEE:** A registration fee of three hundred fifty pesos ( P350.00) shall be charged each participant to defray expenses from board and lodging, food, training materials and supplies, and other operating expenses.
7. Acknowledging the participations of pupils in this training course contributes to their holistic development, make-up classes should be promptly arranged by their respective class advisers and school principal.
8. Likewise the teacher in this training should make necessary arrangements with the principal in accordance with DepEd Order No. 9 s., 2005 entitled " Instituting measure to increase time on task and ensuring compliance therewith and strict with 180 days Teaching and Learning Guidelines."
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
