- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Curriculum and Instruction strand and the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE), announces the conduct of the Presentation Portfolio Assessment (PPA) Year 3 for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Elementary and Junior High School Program Completers for School Year 2021-2022 shall be used as basis for the issuance of an Elementary and Junior High School Certificate.
- 2. The Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) through the ALS Unit shall conduct the said presentation portfolio assessment beginning May 16 to July 31, 2022 from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at the respective ALS Community Learning Centers by schedule.
- 3. To expedite the process of assessment and to ensure the validity and credibility of learner's documents and work outputs, ALS teachers are instructed to conduct initial assessment of the presentation portfolios of their learners prior to the above-stated schedule. Likewise, this Office, through this memorandum, designates the following ALS teachers of this division to serve as validators during the said assessment.

- 4. To strictly observe the implementation of the required minimum public health standards, the Education Program Specialist II for ALS and the designated validators, who shall work hand in hand during the entire process, are directed to accommodate teachers/learners in a limited and safer face-to-face manner, to wit: one-at-a-time and by schedule basis.
- 5. Learners who are over sixty-five (65) years of age, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, or other health risks, pregnant, and learners in special cases shall not be required to report to ALS Community Learning Centers for face-to-face assessment. For them, ALS teachers and validators must come up with the online modality of all activities related to the Presentation Portfolio Assessment.
