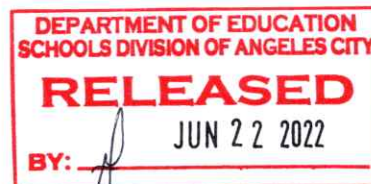

1. This is to announce the schedule of activities relative to the opening of the 21st Century Classroom for the teachers and learners and other stakeholders, to wit:


