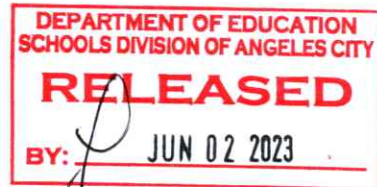

As part of the Philippines' international commitment to the ASEAN School Sports Council (ASSC) being one of its member-countries, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall participate to the 13th ASEAN Schools Games (ASG) scheduled in August 2023 in Da Nang, Vietnam.

Aside from the Philippines, the participating ASSC member-countries to the ASG are Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

To ensure the effective selection of the best and finest learner-athletes, specifically for Athletics and Swimming, who shall form part of the Philippine delegation and compete to the said international school sports competition, the DepEd, through the Bureau of Learner Support Service-School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD), shall conduct a **National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG** scheduled from June 08 to 10, 2023 at the following venues:

**NATIONAL TRY-OUT INVITATION FOR ATHLETICS
AND SWIMMING FOR THE 13TH ASEAN SCHOOLS GAMES
GENERAL INFORMATION AND SELECTION GUIDELINES**

I. BACKGROUND

As part of the Philippines' international commitment to the ASEAN School Sports Council (ASSC) being one of its member-countries, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall participate to the **13th ASEAN Schools Games (ASG)** scheduled in **August 2023** in **Da Nang, Vietnam**.

The ASG is an annual sports competition organized under the ASSC and participated in by secondary school students from its 10 member-countries. It aims to promote ASEAN solidarity in our youth through school sports and provide opportunities for school-athletes to benchmark their sporting talents. ASG also serves as a venue to interact and engage in cultural exchanges within the ASEAN counterparts.

Aside from the Philippines, the participating countries are Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

The Philippines shall compete in five (5) sports disciplines in the 13th ASG namely Athletics (boys/girls); Swimming (boys/girls); Badminton (boys/girls); Basketball (boys/girls); and Pencak Silat (boys/girls).

The DepEd, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services–School Sports Division (BLSS–SSD), shall spearhead the constitution of the Philippine delegation particularly the learner-athletes who will be competing in the five (5) aforementioned sports in the 13th ASG.

II. SELECTION OF LEARNER-ATHLETES FOR THE 13TH ASG

To ensure the effective selection of the best and finest learner-athletes, specifically for Athletics and Swimming, who shall form part of the Philippine delegation and compete to the 13th ASG, the DepEd, a **National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG** shall be conducted.

The National Tryout Invitation shall be extended to the best and finest learner-athletes in the country who will meet the qualifying standards from the 2019 ASG podium finish results for Athletics and Swimming based on their current record in recent competitions such as the *Palarong Pambansa* regional meets and other national sports association (NAS)-sanctioned competitions.

A Technical Working Committee (TWC), composed of distinguished personalities and experts in the field of Athletics and Swimming and selected personnel from the BLSS–SSD, shall be formed to formulate guidelines and rules on the conduct of the most appropriate, efficient, and effective manner of identification and selection of the best learner-athletes for Athletics and Swimming that will form part of the Philippine delegation.

III. PARTICIPATION

A. Learner-Athletes

1. Participation shall be by invitation only. Participants may comprise of learner-athletes who competed in the recently concluded *Palarong Pambansa* regional meets or those athletes selected by recognized Athletics and Swimming coaches who have the potential to compete at the international level.
2. In compliance with the ASSC eligibility requirement, the learner-athlete must be 18 years old or younger as of 1st January in the year of the ASG will be conducted. (i.e. *players born in 2005 or later will be eligible for the 13th ASG*);
3. Learner-athletes must be a bonafide student enrolled in a public or private school at the time of the competition. Players who are foreign nationals but studying full-time in the Philippines may be allowed to participate; and
4. Learner-athletes must meet the qualifying standards from the 2019 ASG podium finish results for Athletics and Swimming in order to be considered for the National Try-out.

B. Technical Officials

1. DepEd personnel who will serve as technical officials in the National Try-out Invitation shall be selected by the TWC.

IV. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

A. Learner-Athletes

1. Duly accomplished registration form;
2. Certificate of enrollment from the school principal the learner-athlete/s is/are currently enrolled;
3. Photocopy of Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)-issued birth certificate; and
4. Parental consent with waiver.

B. Technical Officials

1. Approved travel authority duly signed by their respective head of office.

VI. CONFIRMATION OF SELECTION

Learner-athletes who have been finally selected to be part of the Philippine delegation to compete in the 13th ASG Athletics and Swimming competitions shall be notified through an official communication two (2) weeks after the National Try-out Invitation.

VII. HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The minimum health standards and safety protocols shall be observed in the conduct of the National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG and ensure the safety and well-being of all participants, especially the learner-athletes.

Participants for Athletics shall be billeted at DepEd PASS Dormitory, DepEd Complex, MERALCO Avenue, Pasig City while Swimming participants shall be housed at DepEd NEAP, Marikina City.

The National Tryout Invitation shall be extended to all learner-athletes from across the 17 regions who will meet the qualifying standards based on the 2019 ASG podium finish results for Athletics and Swimming. The qualifications for the participating learner-athletes and other relevant information are contained in the enclosed *General Information on the National Try-Out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG*.

All concerned are enjoined to authorize the participation of the identified learner-athletes and DepEd personnel to the National Try-Out Invitation, as contained in the enclosed *List of Participating Learner-Athletes, Technical Officials, and Members of Various Working Committees to the National Try-Out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG*.

DepEd teaching personnel who will serve as technical officials during the said activity shall be entitled to service credits in accordance to DepEd Order (DO) No. 53, s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*.

In observance of and compliance to DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022 entitled *School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023*, the concerned schools division offices, through the school heads, shall ensure that a substitute teacher will take over the classes in the absence of their respective teaching personnel who will participate to the National Try-Out Invitation to prevent disruption of classes.

Expenses to be incurred for food and accommodation of participants, including travel expenses of technical officials and members of the working committees, shall be charged against the 2023 Physical Fitness and School Sports (PFSS) Funds while travel expenses of the delegation (regional sports officers, learner-athletes, coaches/chaperones, etc.) shall be charged against their respective local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
