1. In preparation for the 2023 National Festival of Talents (NFOT) per the attached DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 023, s. 2023, dated April 19, 2023, the DepEd Regional Office 3 will conduct the 2023 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) with the theme **“Reinforcing 21st Century Learning and Fostering Creative Industries through Talents and Skills Exhibition”** on **June 17 and 24, 2023**, from 8:00 a.m. onwards at the DepEd RO3 Compound, Matalino St., D.M. Government Center, Maimpis, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.

2. The 2023 RFOT aims to provide opportunities for learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as those from the Alternative Learning System (ALS), Indigenous People Education (IPED), Special Needs Education Program (SNEd), and Madrasah Education Program (MEP) to showcase their talents and skills. It also provides a platform for strengthening teachers' and learners' knowledge and skill sets as they listen to the invaluable insights shared by the panel of experts.

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4. The guidelines that will be used for the following event categories of the 2023 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) **are those that are contained in DepEd Memorandum No. 023, s. 2023:**
 - a. Technolympics for Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), Technical Vocational Education (TVE), and Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL);
 - b. Sining Tanghalan for Music and Arts;
 - c. Population Development for Social Studies (Araling Panlipunan);
 - d. Musabaqah for Madrasah Education Program (MEP);
 - e. SNEd Expo for Special Needs Education (SNEd); and
 - f. STEMazing for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.
 5. All Festival of Talents Focal Persons, coaches, and contestants are hereby enjoined to familiarize themselves with the guidelines stated in the previously mentioned DepEd Memorandum.
 6. All learner-participants and teacher-coaches shall receive a Certificate of Participation, while those who will be within Ranks 1 to 5 shall be given a Certificate of Recognition. All Rank 1 contestants of the different event categories shall participate in the 2023 NFOT.
 7. Schools Division Offices shall submit an official list of participants on or before June 9, 2023, to the Regional Coordinators/ Focal Persons of concerned skills exhibitions duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendents by sending it using the email address region3@deped.gov.ph.
 8. **No registration fee** shall be charged to the participants whose names are included in the official list of delegations.
 9. Meals, snacks, and other expenses of coaches, contestants, trainers, and members of the official delegation including travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged to School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), local and division funds, or other available resources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
 10. Meanwhile, meals of RFOT TWG, IDs, supplies and materials, and other expenses incurred during the conduct of RFOT shall be charged against the support fund to be downloaded by the Central Office.
 11. Since the activities are conducted on Saturdays, teacher participants and teachers who are members of the TWG are entitled to claim service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant*
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of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, management staff, members of the TWG who not teachers and other non-teaching participants shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.*

12. Immediate and wide dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
