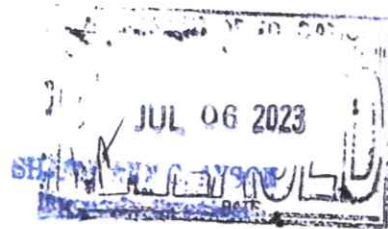

**2023 REGIONAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In support of the Department's policy development process, research agenda, and policy and program development and implementation, DepEd is committed to fostering and enhancing a robust research culture in basic education. Additionally, it recognizes the significance of disseminating and effectively utilizing research findings to enhance learning outcomes, improve the teaching-learning process, and assess their impact at all levels of governance in basic education.
2. Relative to this, DepEd Regional Office III through the Policy, Planning, and Research Division will conduct the **2023 Regional Research Conference** with a theme *"Preparing for the Future of Basic Education through Equitable, Inclusive, and Evidence-Based Post-Pandemic Recovery"* on July 19-21, 2023 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at Eurotel Hotel, located at 1 Don Juico Avenue, Brgy. Malabanas, Angeles City.
3. The objectives of the activity are as follows:
  - 4.1 Provide a platform for select BERF grantees to share their research findings with a broader audience.
  - 4.2 Highlight best practices developed through the conduct of research.
  - 4.3 Identify the unique contributions of the research outputs to DepEd policies and programs.
  - 4.4 Recognize the best research outputs and oral presenters in the region.
4. The activity shall only include approved and completed BERF studies from FY 2020 to FY 2022. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall select one research paper per category for presentation at the conference. A researcher who has been promoted may present a paper he or she conducted in his previous position. All presenters must adhere to the guidelines specified in Annex 1.
5. Participants in the conference are the Senior Education Program Specialist in Planning and Research and all the select research presenters. All the participants are required to be present for the entire duration of the **three-day activity**. Further, all participants are required to come in **business professional attire**. SEPSs in Planning and Research are requested to accomplish the link below

6. All research papers will be evaluated by invited research experts from different organizations and Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). They will choose three exceptional papers (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place) and one best oral paper presenter for each category. All winners will be announced and awarded on the third day of the conference. The research papers of the winners will be published in the DepEd RO3's PROBE Research Journal. Further, SEPS shall serve as moderators for the break-out sessions (See Annex 3).

7. Food and accommodation of the participants shall be charged to the Regional MOOE while the transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to the Division MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Breakfast will be served on the first day of the activity.

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**ANNEX 1: GUIDELINES FOR THE 2023 REGIONAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE**

1. Each SDO will choose one completed BERF research paper per category from FY 2020 to FY 2022.
2. SEPS shall accomplish the link below and upload the abstracts and ppt presentations of all official entries for all official entries across all categories on or before July 10, 2023 using the link:

The abstracts should be named using the format: SDO\_Sub-theme No\_Name. (e.g. Zambales\_SubTheme3\_Juan dela Cruz)

3. Abstracts should not be more than 150-250 words in letter-sized papers, Bookman Style Font 11, and single-spaced. The abstract should contain the following: title of the paper, author/s name, position, school/ Schools Division Office, email address, abstract content, and keywords.
4. The abstract must contain the purpose of the study, research design or methodology, findings, research limitations, implication of the study, originality or value, and keywords.
5. The PowerPoint presentation shall have a maximum of 12 slides. Use the file name format SDO\_Sub-Theme No.\_Name (e.g. San Jose City\_SubTheme 2\_Juan dela Cruz).

The presentation must contain

- 5.1. Introduction (Research Title, Name of the Researcher/s, Rationale, Statement of the Problem)
  - 5.2. Methods (Type of Study/Research Design, sampling, and sampling technique, Participants/Respondents, Instrument, and/or statistical tests or data analysis techniques)
  - 5.3. Results and Discussion (in tabular format only)
  - 5.4. Conclusion and Recommendations
6. Oral presentation using PowerPoint will be for 10 minutes only which will be followed by a five-minute question and answer.
  7. All research papers that will be presented will be evaluated by invited panel of research experts. The order of oral presentation of the different themes for evaluation are as follows:
    - Day 1 - Sub-themes 1 (Teachers) and 2 (School



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- Administrators)
- Day 2 – Sub-themes 3 (Supervisors) and 4 (Non-Teaching Personnel)
  - Day 3 – Sub-theme 5 (Special Program Coordinators)
8. Each presenter must have a backup file of his/her PPT if technical glitches will be experienced during the presentation.
  5. Presenters must be in the specified breakout session room 15 minutes before their scheduled presentations.
  6. The moderators will be responsible for facilitating the smooth transition of presentations and moderating the question-and-answer sessions, ensuring a seamless flow of the event.
