PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL SCHOOL MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES (MOOE) FUNDS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor, SGOD & CID Division Accountant and Division Budget Officer Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads and OIC's All Others Concerned

- 1. In connection with DepEd Memorandum OUF-2023-515, OUF-2023-0445, and OUF-2023-0139, the DepEd Central Office allocated additional MOOE to schools that are in dire need of funds.
- 2. With reference to Sub-Allotment Release Order (Sub-ARO) No. OSEC-3-23-3753 received on August 10, 2023, the following schools have additional MOOE:

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- 3. To facilitate the downloading of subsidy, all concerned Schools Heads are enjoined to submit two (2) copies of the signed Obligation Request and Status (ORS) and approved Project Proposal on or before **Aug. 29, 2023**, to the Budget Unit. Secondary Schools with Fiscal Autonomy shall receive sub-Allotment Release Order (Sub-ARO) from the Division Office and are exempted from submitting the signed Obligation Request and Status (ORS).
- 4. The use of the additional MOOE is to fund proposed programs, projects, and activities in support of the National Learning Recovery Plan of the school and shall be consistent with the following issuances:
 - a. DepEd Memorandum No. 039, s. 2020 "Authorizing the Use of Regular Allocations for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses and/or Local Funds to Implement Measures in Preparing and Responding to the COVID-19 Threats", dated March 12, 2020
 - b. **DepEd Order No. 008, s. 2019** "Revised Implementing Guidelines on the Direct Release, Use, Monitoring and Reporting of Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses Allocation of Schools, Including Other Funds Managed by Schools", dated May 2, 2019
 - c. **DepEd Order No. 014, s. 2020** "Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools", dated June 25, 2020
 - d. **DepEd Order No. 015, s. 2020** "Supplementary Guidelines on Managing Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses Allocation for Schools to Support the Implementation of Basic Education Learning and Continuity Plan in time of COVID-19", dated June 25, 2020
 - e. **DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023,** "Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024", dated August 4, 2023
- 5. The use of the said funds shall be subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, auditing, and procurement rules and regulations.

- I. On March 8, 2023, per the instruction of the Vice President and Secretary, OUF-2023-0139¹ on the "Call for Requests Needing Additional Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) Fund". The following parameters were set:
 - a. The request provides a concept note with corresponding specific deliverables and outputs, supporting documents and computation on costing, and the computation of existing MOOE and proof of utilization of the Office, or reasons as to the inadequacy of the MOOE;
 - b. The request will be obligated, implemented, accepted, and paid until December 31, 2023; and
 - c. The request is compliant with the provisions of existing policies thereof and is subject to existing rules and regulations on budgeting, accounting, procurement, and auditing.
- II. On June 26, 2023, this Office issued OUF-2023-04452 on the "Response to Requests for Additional MOOE from Regional Offices (ROs), Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and Schools", simply stating that:
 - a. That this Office is constrained to approve all the submitted requests;
 - All requests from schools will be returned without favorable consideration since the proposals do not adhere to the requirements indicated in OUF-2023-0139; and
 - c. Since most of the proposals include additional funding for regular operations, the FY 2024 proposal for School MOOE was increased by 20%.

- III. Hence, this Advisory is being issued to inform everyone that the Requested Additional MOOE shall be downloaded to your respective Offices. The breakdown thereof is attached as **Annex "C"**.
 - a. The proposed computation of the allocation is based on the Curricular Offering and LGU Income Classification excluding those RO/SDO/Schools that have already received additional Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE). The specific details of these exceptions amount to \$35,969,974.003.

For Regional Office/Schools Division Office Proper:

MOOE Allocation = Cost Multiplier based on Size Classification of the Region / Division

For Schools:

MOOE Allocation = Cost Multiplier (Modified Curricular Offering Classification) + Cost Multiplier (LGU Income Class)

Funding sources shall be the Continuing (FY 2022) and Current (FY 2023) funds under the General Management and Supervision - MOOE (GMS - MOOE). Specifically:

- c. The Schools Division Office shall receive two sets of sub-Allotment Release Orders - one for the Schools Division Office Proper, and one for the Schools. The Schools Division Office has the discretion to prioritize schools that are in dire need of the additional MOOE. This aims to address the school's specific needs and ensure the efficient allocation of resources.
- IV. Everyone is enjoined to ensure judicious expenditure of said funds and to submit a report on the utilization of the downloaded funds to this Office, during the 1st week of January 2024, for subsequent submission to the Office of the Secretary. This refers to OUF-2023-0139 on the "Call for Requests Needing Additional Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) Fund" dated March 8, 2023.

This Office acknowledges the significance of the different requested programs, projects, and activities, recognizing the necessity of repairs and improvements to school facilities, the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) equipment in curriculum and instruction, and training to support effective teaching and learning, and the potential benefits it can bring to the Department and, ultimately, to the learners.

Having additional funds is important to meet the increasing demand for learning opportunities while dealing with rising commodity costs. However, after a thorough evaluation, this Office is constrained to approve all the submitted requests. In line with this, all requests from schools will be returned without favorable consideration since the proposals do not adhere to the requirements indicated in OUF-2023-0139. Additionally, since most of the proposals include additional funding for regular operations, MOOE in the field offices still needs to be increased to fund these expenses. To address this concern, the FY 2024 proposal for School MOOE was **increased by 20%**.

Further, the Central Office has allocated PhP1.5 billion to fund proposed programs in support of the National Learning Recovery Program. These funds will be downloaded to Regional Offices to facilitate the implementation of the recovery initiatives at the school level.
