- 2. The participants are all school heads, select public elementary and secondary teachers, select Teachers Club officers, and select division key officials. School heads who have attended the National Assembly of Education may opt to send teachers as representatives of their schools.
- 3. Attached are the list of participants and Regional Memorandum No. 545, s. 2023, for reference and guidance. Schools with changes to the names of participants should inform the SGOD-HRD unit on or before November 3, 2023.
- 4. All expenses to be incurred for the said activity shall be charged to School MOOE for participants from schools and Division MOOE funds for participants from the division office, subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures, rules, and regulations.
- 5. Payment for the registration fee in the amount of four thousand pesos (**Php 4,000.00**) per participant may be deposited in the Central Luzon Association of Schools Superintendents (CLASS) Landbank Savings Account No. While expenses for hotel accommodation and transportation amounting to three thousand pesos (**Php 3,000.00**) shall be paid to the division cashier, The deadline for payment is November 3, 2023.



2023 CENTRAL LUZON ASSEMBLY OF EDUCATION LEADERS (CLAEL)

To: The Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents Chiefs of Regional Function Divisions

- 1. Consistent with the advocacy of the Department of Education (DepEd) to ensure the successful implementation of the *MATATAG* Curriculum in the School Year 2024-2025, this Office announces that the Central Luzon Association of Schools Superintendents (CLASS) in collaboration with the Chiefs of the Regional Function Divisions will conduct the 2023 Central Luzon Assembly of Education Leaders (CLAEL) at Subic Bay Exhibit and Convention Center (SBECC) in Olongapo City, on November 21-22, 2023.
- 2. The primordial objective of this assembly is to provide education stakeholders with the opportunity to understand the MATATAG Curriculum, and to enjoin their support for the revised curriculum. Hence, the theme of this year's conference is "Strengthening Stakeholders' Collaboration towards a Resilient Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum."
- 3. Participants are the key officials of DepEd Regional Office III, Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, select supervisors, select school heads, select teachers of public elementary and secondary schools, heads/representatives from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs), and Local Government Units (LGUs).
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (Php 4,000.00) shall be collected from each participant to defray the expenditures for the venue, honoraria of speakers, kits, snacks, lunch, and dinner. Participants will take charge of their own breakfast and hotel accommodation.
- 5. Other relative expenditures to be incurred by the participants such as board and lodging and travel expenses may be charged to the INSET/MOOE/local funds subject to the availability of funds and in adherence to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Participants are required to register online through a link to be provided to Schools Division Offices (SDOs), followed by the online payment of the registration fee in the Bank Account Name and Number of the Central Luzon Association of

Schools Superintendents (CLASS). The details of the online registration and payment shall be issued in a separate memorandum.

- 7. The SEPS-HRDs of the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) are requested to assist in the registration of participants. The link of the google sheet for the list of participants per SDO shall be forwarded to the SEPS-HRD.

- 9. It is strongly encouraged that the number of slots per SDO will be distributed as follows: 70 percent for school heads, 20 percent for SDO personnel, and 10 percent for external stakeholders and other guests. Priority participants are the Officers of Faculty/Teacher Organizations, Public Secondary School Principals' Association (PSSPA), Region III/Division, and Public Elementary School Principals' Association (PESPA), Region III/Division. For select teacher representatives, each SDO shall have the following slots: one teacher for key stage 1, one teacher for key stage 2, and one teacher for key stage 3.
- 10. Moreover, those who attended the National Assembly of Education Leaders (NAEL) last July 2023 at SMX Convention Center in Pasay City may be excluded from the list of participants to give others the chance to participate in this activity.
- 11. Enclosed are the Planning and Technical Work Committees, for information and proper guidance.
