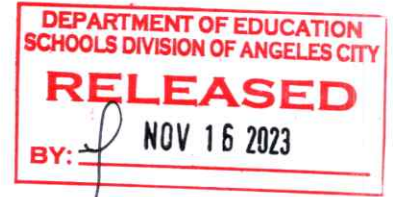

**DIVISION OBSERVANCE OF THE 18-DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE
AGAINST WOMEN (VAW)**

To : Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Proclamation 1172, s. 2006 declares November 25 to December 12 of every year as the **“18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW)”** which envisions a community free from all forms of violence against women and girls, it also reiterates a meaningful action in the form of a campaign of government agencies in the Philippines.
2. The activity aims:
 - 2.1 to promote awareness on the impact of violence against women;
 - 2.2 to establish and promote safe spaces within the SDO Angeles City community where individuals can seek support, share experience, and access resources without judgement; and
 - 2.3 to increase community awareness on the prevalence and impact of violence through advocacy materials.
3. In line with this, all schools are invited to conduct simple initiatives to increase awareness about the observance of this 18-day campaign during their flag ceremonies and in other activities, if applicable. It may also include advocacy campaign via Facebook page, posting of stories of empowered survivors and hope, posting of Men and women supporting VAWC on FB Page, and conduct of webinars/seminars/LAC sessions on Safe Space Act/Bawal. Bastos Law/ or other related activity.
3. Teachers are encouraged to facilitate activities that promote women empowerment or positive behavior among learners during classroom breaks, before or after classes. Schools may also conduct “Komustahan” activity, art expressions, discussions promote opportunity to reflect on the impact of violence against women and children.
