PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR THE EXTREME HEAT IN SCHOOLS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. In support to the Department of Education's MATATAG Agenda and in consideration of the learners' and personnel's well-being, safety, and protection, this Office reiterates DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022: Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions and Other Calamities.
- 2. Moreover, teachers are given the option to wear comfortable clothing aside from the regular uniforms to reduce the heat inside the classrooms provided that they adhere to Republic Act No. 6713: Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards of Public Officials and Employees and Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 19, s. 2000: Revised Dress Code Prescribed for All Government Officials and Employees in the Workplace.
- 3. Learners are also encouraged to prioritize their comfort and well-being by wearing decent attire, staying hydrated with ample water intake, and utilizing essential items such as umbrellas, fans, and face towels to help maintain ideal conditions.
- 4. Other applicable precautionary measures may also be implemented to address concerns brought by the dry season or extreme hot weather.
- 5. Wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
