**SUBJECT :** **LAUNCH OF THE FIRST NATIONAL CAREER EXPO 2024 UNDER THE CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM**

**DATE :** May 01, 2024

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), shall spearhead the conduct of the first **National Career Expo (NCEX) 2024**, under the **Career Guidance Program (CGP)** targeting three (3) clusters (Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao) in **May 2024**.

NCEX 2024 shall be co-hosted by DepEd Regional Offices namely, **DepEd-National Capital Region (NCR)**, **DepEd-Regional Office VI (Western Visayas)**, and **DepEd-Regional Office XI (Davao)**. The schedule of activities are as follows:

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One of the major collaborative initiatives for CGP this School Year (S.Y.) 2023-2024 is the **launch of the first NCEx nationwide**. It focuses on developing the essential skills necessary for 21st-century learners to be equipped in their future career exploration, address the skills mismatch among secondary-level learners, and provide an opportunity to explore the workforce as one of the options among the four curriculum exits offered by the Senior High School (SHS) program.

This activity is anchored in the Republic Act (RA) 10533, otherwise known as the **Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013**, in which it is stated that career advocacy activities for secondary-level students shall be regularly conducted. The activity also follows through on one of the major objectives of **RA 11206**, otherwise known as the **Secondary School Career Guidance and Counseling Act**, which aims to “equip secondary education students with the capability to make educated career decisions and expose them to relevant labor markets”.

NCEx 2024 shall advocate for inter-agency partnerships with the **Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)**, **Commission on Higher Education (CHED)**, **Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)**, **Department of Trade and Industry (DTI)**, and the **private sectors** among others. Collaborations across agencies will serve as a venue for learners to get access to programs and career development services.

NCEx 2024 aims to gather SHS learners, education stakeholders, partner organizations, and private sectors in providing an opportunity for the learners to network, build professional contacts, and explore available internship and employment opportunities for career development. In particular:

- a. It shall serve as a platform for potential employers (i.e. industry representatives, companies, private institutions, etc.) to find learners that can fill their entry-level positions or to collect a pool of talents for their internship programs.
- b. Higher Education schools and universities should promote their degree programs especially those that may introduce the learners to alternative and lesser-known fields of study and career paths, tailored to their regional contexts. They shall also introduce the learners to available and relevant scholarship opportunities.
- c. Successful and notable entrepreneurs, small and medium-sized businesses can share business ideas, best practices, and livelihood programs to the learners to provide them insight into paths to entrepreneurship.

- d. TESDA, alongside other accredited skills development institutions, can promote middle skills development as a viable path in which learners can establish their future careers.

DepEd Undersecretaries, Assistant Secretaries, Minister of Basic, Higher, and Technical Education of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), Bureau and Service Directors, representatives of invited offices, and members of the working committees are invited to attend in this endeavor.

BLSS-YFD shall oversee the overall planning, preparation, implementation, and evaluation of NCEx 2024. Also, it shall work in close coordination with the Office of the Regional Directors of NCR, Region VI, and Region XI. These DepEd Regional Offices shall provide the necessary administrative and logistical support and assistance to the activity.

BLSS-YFD shall convene the different Working Committees which will be composed of members representing various offices in DepEd, Local Government Units (LGUs), and host regions to assist the implementation of all preparatory activities, event proper, and event evaluation and monitoring.

Expenses incurred for this activity shall be charged to Learner Support Program (LSP) 2024 Current Funds. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of selected participants and their chaperones shall be charged to Local Funds, Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Local School Board - Special Education Fund (LSB-SEF), and other applicable fund source/s, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Other details specific to this event shall be issued on separate advisories.
